2018 Paediatric Update No. 1

The Paediatric Update No. 1 of our College will be held on **10 June 2018 (Sunday afternoon)** from **2pm to 5pm** at **Queen Elizabeth Hospital**. There are two important themes - **Revising our Curriculum & Gut Microbiome**”.

Our College has initiated a review and exploring a revision of the current training and assessment systems. The HK College of Anaesthesiologists, through committed work and after arduous deliberation, is implementing a new curriculum this July. In order to learn from the piloting good work of our Sister College, we are very fortunate to have Dr CH Koo and Dr Ling Szeto of the HKCA to share their valuable experience.

Scientific publications on the Gut Microbiome are flourishing and the clinical applications have caused significant attention, sometimes even mythical beliefs. Dr Arthur Mak and Prof TF Leung will talk on its relation to mental health and childhood allergies. They will give us insightful knowledge and evidence-based applications to guide our practice.

**HKAM Training Scholarship
(Revised)**

Objectives of the scholarship

1. The Academy sets up the scholarship with an intention to promote specialist training, encourage interchange and broaden training opportunities both in Hong Kong and the Mainland. The scholarship aims to provide for specialist trainees and young Fellows:-
 - a) wider exposure in the scope of medical practice and thus improving the standard and quality of training, and
 - b) opportunities to develop networking among specialist trainees of both areas to stimulate further interflow.

Eligible Candidates

2. The following persons are eligible to apply for scholarship:-
 - a) Specialist trainees;
 - b) Young Fellows (those who have become Fellows within 10 years prior to the date of application);
 - c) Examination Eligible Candidates (those who have completed specialist training but not yet passed their exit examinations);
 - d) Doctors with status equivalent to (a) to (c) in Mainland
3. Applications from candidates in Hong Kong must be supported by the respective Academy College. Applications from candidates in Mainland would be accepted based on recommendations from respective counterparts in Mainland.

Selection criteria

4. All candidates must possess a reasonable standard of spoken and written English as well as Putonghua. Priority will be given to candidates who are in the later part of specialists training and to those who can obtain full clinical training attachments. In general, the following factors will be considered:-
 - a) Relevancy of the available training post to the specialty stream of the applicant;
 - b) Reasons of nomination by the applicant's supporting institution;
 - c) Detailed plan of training during the training period;

- d) Anticipated benefits, e.g. impact of the expertise to be acquired in relation to a candidate's training development and home territory.
- e) Clinical experience and scientific background of the applicant.

Scholarship coverage

- 5. Each scholarship will cover:-
 - a) a training period from 1 month to 6 months;
 - b) return passage, inclusive of airport taxes between Hong Kong and Mainland by the most economical means;
 - c) monthly subsistence and accommodation allowance during the training period;
 - d) personal medical health insurance;
 - e) insurance (at government/HA's rate) against medical malpractice claims in the receiving institutions during the training period;
 - f) any other training fees that may be incurred during this period will be approved on a case by case basis (e.g. attending other workshops).
- 6. The applicant is expected to submit the claims for reimbursement and a written report to the Education Committee within 3 months of completion of the scholarship training.

Budget

- 7. The maximum spending per year will be capped at HK\$0.5M.

- Table and graphics should be kept to a minimum.
- Choose the way the abstract is to be presented (Oral or Poster or either).
