#### **Examination Committee**

Please note the following changes to the rule requiring candidates to resit the MRCPCH Part 1a and b:

# Candidates who obtained their MRCPCH Part I (or claimed any exempting qualification from the MRCPCH Part I) Pre - January 2004

The current Paper 1a and the Paper 1b are very different from the old style of the MRCPCH Part I Examination that was in place before January 2004. As a result anyone that obtained (passed) their MRCPCH Part I before January 2004 <u>must</u> re-sit both Paper 1a and Paper 1b.

# Candidates who obtained their MRCPCH Part I (or claimed any exempting qualification from the MRCPCH Part I) Post - January 2004

January 2004 was when the new style of the MRCPCH Part I (Paper 1a and Paper 1b) was introduced. Therefore candidates that obtained (passed) their MRCPCH Part I <u>after</u> January 2004 *must* re-sit Paper 1b **ONLY**.

#### and now:

All candidates regardless of when and where they sat their Part 1, need only retake Part 1b. This is what we will put on the results letters for the affected candidates:

You have now come to the end of your Seven-Year Registration Period of the MRCPCH Part 1 examination. You will now only be required to re-sit and pass the Paper 1b of the MRCPCH Part 1 Examination. Once you successfully complete the Paper 1b of the MRCPCH Part 1 Examination you will then have a new Seven-Year Registration Period and any remaining Clinical examination attempts may then be taken. Candidates are allowed a maximum of 3 attempts as long as they do not exceed the Seven-year MRCPCH registration period.
