Training and Assessment

Re-vamping of specialty training and assessment

College is currently working on a re-vamping of our paediatric specialty training programme and assessment of trainees

Initial plan to focus on the higher training programme

Move towards work place-based assessment ("DOPS", case-based discussion, ongoing feedback) or supervised learning events ("SLEs")

Focus areas: clinical handover, advanced care planning/palliative care, communication skills

Trainer/supervisor roles

Consider establishing "educational supervisors" to support and expand the role of the training supervisor in guiding the careers and overall educational plan of trainees

Will initiate train-the-trainer programmes to improve trainee supervision and training

Will use IT platforms to facilitate documentation of training/learning activities of trainees

Duties of the visiting team

Conduct field and ward visits

Interview

- COS and staff members
- Trainees individually (i.e., not in presence of senior staff)

Decide whether further data or re-visit is required before the routine 5year visits

Decide whether or not to recommend training centre for reaccreditation

Complete Appendix II and re-accreditation report

Visit structure

- 1. Training centres submit data to the visiting team via the Accreditation Committee
 - a) Deadline in Feb 2017 for training centres to be visited between Mar and May 2017
 - b) Deadline in Apr 2017 for training centres to be visited between Jun and Aug 2017
- 2. Visiting teams will:
 - a) Meet before the visit to decide whether further data are required and what to focus on
 - b) Visit the training centre
 - c) Complete Appendix II
 - d) Decide whether further data or revisits are required
 - e) Draft report for submission to the Accreditation Committee

Accreditation Committee and then Council will review report to decide upon reaccreditation
