40th Exit Assessment

The 40th Exit Assessment will be held on 21st June 2018. The closing date for receipt of completed application forms and associated documents is 3rd April 2018. Details of application and forms can be downloaded from the College website.

For all trainees who started their basic paediatric training on or after 1st July 2009, a proof of completion of a formal **Child Protection Course** within their 6-year Paediatric Training Programme should be submitted along with the application.

Dissertations submitted by Exit Assessment candidates will be considered for the **Best Dissertation prize** (**BDP**) which was created in 2015 and awarded annually to the best dissertation submitted for Exit Assessments. Case reports, however, will not be considered for the prize.

The BDP includes a cash prize of HK\$3,000 and will be presented at the College Annual Dinner in December.

2018 Best Young Investigator Prize

To encourage research by colleagues, the Best Young Investigator Prize was created in 2015 to be awarded annually to the best paper published between 1st July of previous year and 30th June of the awarding year.

Eligibility

Entry into the Best Young Investigator Prize competition is voluntary.

Applicants must be members of the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians (including Associate Members, Members and Fellows) AND aged 46 years or under <u>as at 30th June 2018</u>.

The papers should be published in peer-reviewed print or electronic journals, and written in English or translated into English if they are written in languages other than English.

Only the first author **or** corresponding author is eligible to apply. One paper is eligible for only one submission, and each paper will be allowed to compete for only one prize.

If the paper has previously been awarded the Best Dissertation Prize of the College prior to publication, it will not be eligible for the Best Young Investigator Prize and vice versa.

The decision of the assessment panel will be final.

Submission

Submission deadline for the year 2018 Prize is 31st August 2018. Interested colleagues can email their papers (PDF or MS Word format) together with the Application Form (Appendix I) to the College Secretariat (enquiry@paediatrician.org.hk) on or before 31st August 2018.

The Best Young Investigator Prize will include a cash reward of HK\$5,000 and will be presented during the College annual dinner in December.

Hong Kong College of Paediatricians HM Lui Memorial Fund

The Hong Kong College of Paediatricians established the HM Lui Memorial Fund in Year 2001 to promote postgraduate study and research in liver diseases and related disciplines in children.

Applications are invited for the HM Lui Fellowship, which will be awarded to residents of Hong Kong SAR who are able to meet the following minimum criteria:

The HM Lui Fellowship

The HM Lui Fellowship will be awarded to paediatricians for education, training and research in overseas countries **in any field of Paediatrics**, preferably liver diseases and gastroenterology in the year 2018. The applicant must be aged below 40 years; residents of Hong Kong SAR and are currently working in Hong Kong SAR.

The award of the Fellowship will consist of:

- 1. Round trip airfare (economy class) by the most economical route.
- 2. Monthly allowance of HK\$12,000-HK\$15,000.
- 3. Reimbursement of course fees and books up to HK\$6,000.

The award of the Fellowship shall range from three (3) to twelve (12) months. <u>Application must be made by nomination by the Head of the Department of Paediatrics or Hospital Chief Executive</u>. **The deadline of application is 31 March 2018.**
