Termination of 3 Clinical Attempts Restriction - MRCPCH & DCH

The RCPCH has recently decided to discontinue the three-attempt ruling for both MRCPCH Clinical and DCH Clinical examinations effective July 2012.

All MRCPCH and DCH candidates who are still within their 7-year registration period and who have passed all the written requirements of both examinations will now be <u>allowed as many attempts as required</u> to pass the clinical element of their exams.

All exams must still be <u>completed within 7 years</u> from the date of successfully completing MRCPCH Part IB (written).

Maternal and Child Health Conference 2012 "Maternal & Child Health: The Foundation of Population Health"

The Department of Health is going to hold a Conference entitled 'Maternal and Child Health: The Foundation of Population Health' to commemorate 80 years of maternal and child health service in Hong Kong. The Conference will be held at the Harbour Grand Hong Kong in North Point on 7^{th} & 8^{th} September 2012. There are also pre-conference seminars from $4^{th}-6^{th}$ September 2012.

A number of overseas and local experts have been invited to share their knowledge and best practices on the following four main themes:

- 1. Social determinants of health;
- 2. Early child development;
- 3. Developmental origins of health & disease; and
- 4. Infant & young child feeding.
