Updates on Relaxation of 3 MRCPCH Clinical Attempts Regulation

The Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health (RCPCH) implemented a trial relaxation of the 3 clinical attempts regulation in MRCPCH Clinical Examinations last year effective from October 2011 to February 2012. The RCPCH recently further extended this trial period to the **June 2012** MRCPCH Clinical examination, until a decision is made on the future of the relaxation regulation.

Candidates who have exhausted their 3 Clinical attempts during this trial period <u>AND</u> have not attempted the MRCPCH Part 2 examination are not required to retake Part 2 Written Examination before sitting for MRCPCH Clinical during this period.

Maternal Child Health Conference

The Department of Health is going to celebrate the 80th anniversary of the establishment of the Maternal & Child Health Service in Hong Kong this year. They are going to organize a conference entitled "Maternal & Child Health: the foundation of population health", which will be held on **7th & 8th (Friday & Saturday) September 2012**. The 4 themes are: (1) Developmental Origins of Health
