### Pediatric Care Online (PCO) Service Open to All Fellows/ Members/ Associate Members

Our College has signed a License Agreement with the American Academy of Pediatrics so that our Fellows/ Members/ Associate Members are welcome to apply as authorized users of the Pediatric Care Online Service. This is an initial one-year contract, renewable annually, depending upon satisfactory utilization rate and positive feedback from users.

Our authorised users have already begun taking advantage of the online service for quick and reliable information relevant to their clinical practice since 1 May, 2010. Altogether there are 500 user codes available, about half being filled to date. We

would like to urge interested paediatricians to email to the college secretariat ([enquiry@paediatrician.org](mailto:enquiry@paediatrician.org)) as soon as possible for application.

The AAP expects all authorized users to register with their user codes no later than 30 June, 2010. So do hurry up and get registered!

### **Fact finding trip to Guizhou**

The Hong Kong College of Paediatricians Foundation will organize a "Fact finding trip" to Guiyang in the Guizhou Province from 5-8 September 2010, to visit the health authority of Guizhou Province and explore the possibility of having a Neonatal resuscitation Course there next year. Members of the college are welcome to join and the details will be announced later.

### **New progress in the status of the Hong Kong Journal of Paediatrics (HKJP)**

With the continuous and valuable contributions from both local and overseas paediatricians, the HKJP is gradually gaining recognition from the international scientific community. In the latest evaluation by the Scopus, a citation information network based on Elsevier databases including Biobase, Embase etc., HKJP ranks 129<sup>th</sup> in a total of 174 journals classified under "Pediatrics, Perinatology and Child Health". Scopus is a citation tracking service similar to the impact factor of Thomson Reuters ISI Web of Science. As the HKJP is indexed in Embase, citations can automatically be tracked by Scopus. Among the indicators produced by Scopus, "Cites per Documents (2 years)" measures the average citations per document in a 2 year period. It is computed considering the amount of citations received by a journal in the current year to the documents published in the two previous years, similar formula used by the Impact Factor. The Cites per Documents in 2008 for the Journal is 0.05. This biennial event is a good opportunity for colleagues from Hong Kong and Mainland China to meet and share their clinical and research experience. This will be a whole day meeting on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2010 at the Shangri-la Hotel, Shenzhen (深圳市羅湖區香格里拉酒店). Participants may choose to travel on Friday 25 June 2010 and stay overnight, or travel on early Saturday morning on 26 June 2010. Since the Hotel is just 5 minutes walk from Lowu Station, it is more convenient for participants to travel by train and go to the venue by themselves. The Meeting will last from 8:00

am to 8:00 pm. The Hong Kong delegation will return to Hong Kong in the evening of 26 June 2010. The preliminary program and registration form is attached (see appendix).

Associate members, Members and Fellows of the College are welcome to apply but priority will be given to trainees since the course has become a mandatory requirement for Paediatric Fellowship curriculum. ### **Announcement by Working Group on Accreditation of Paediatric Subspecialties - Open nomination for the post of the Director of Subspecialty Boards**

As we have announced before, the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians has a statutory responsibility to ensure the standard and quality of paediatric practice through a reliable system of training, accreditation, and continuous professional development. With the advance in tertiary services and the planning of the future Centre of Excellence in Paediatrics, there is a need for a proper accreditation system of subspecialists. Through the work of the previous Task Force for Accreditation of Higher Training of Paediatric Subspecialties (from 2000 to 2008), and the succeeding Working Group on Accreditation of Paediatric Subspecialties, the College has laid down the guidelines and procedures for subspecialty accreditation. In May 2009, the College Council has endorsed to add Section 10 (Subspecialty Affairs) in the College Byelaws, which stipulates the appointment of the Director of Subspecialty Boards.

We hereby announce the opening of nomination to this important post. Any interested Fellow who satisfies the following two criteria can be nominated:

1. A Fellow with at least 10 years post College Fellowship experience.
2. Having good professional standing and experience in Paediatrics and Child Health.

Interested Fellows should sign and submit the attached nomination form (appendix 1), together with his/her brief curriculum vitae stating the relevant experience. The nomination should be made by two College Fellows.

The College Council will select the most suitable candidate, taking into consideration the following attributes:

1. Having experience in developing and supervising subspecialty training programmes.
2. Having served in the Council or Standing Committees of the College (be familiar with the operation of the College).
3. Having been involved in the development of subspecialty accreditation guidelines of the College.
