# Promotion and Protection of Breastfeeding: a reminder on the International Code of Marketing of Breastmilk Substitutes

As a strategy for promotion and protection of breastfeeding, and in compliance with WHO recommendation, the Hospital Authority (HA) will no longer receive donations of breastmilk substitutes as from 1/4/10. The necessary milk formulae are procured through a tendering process and the brands will be used in rotation. There will be no change in hospital charges to the public nor a need for parents to bring formula milk of their own. Milk formulae suppliers are required to comply with the International Code of Marketing of Breastmilk Substitutes and subsequent relevant World Health Assembly resolutions with no promotion within HA premises. There will be a grace period to comply with the labelling requirement. The Department of Health is currently studying implementation of the Code within the community.

To maintain our support on breastfeeding, our colleagues may like a reminder on the Code. A simplified version is available

# Working Group on Accreditation of Paediatric Subspecialties:

# Open nomination for the post of the Director of Subspecialty Boards

As we have announced before, the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians has a statutory responsibility to ensure the standard and quality of paediatric practice through a reliable system of training, accreditation, and continuous professional development. With the advance in tertiary services and the planning of the future Centre of Excellence in Paediatrics, there is a need for a proper accreditation system of subspecialists. Through the work of the previous Task Force for Accreditation of Higher Training of Paediatric Subspecialties (from 2000 to 2008), and the succeeding Working Group on Accreditation of Paediatric Subspecialties, the College has laid down the guidelines and procedures for subspecialty accreditation. In May 2009, the College Council has endorsed to add Section 10 (Subspecialty Affairs) in the College Byelaws, which stipulates the appointment of the Director of Subspecialty Boards.

We hereby announce the opening of nomination to this important post. Any interested Fellow who satisfies the following two criteria can be nominated:

- 1. A Fellow with at least 10 years post College Fellowship experience.
- 2. Having good professional standing and experience in Paediatrics and Child Health. Interested Fellows should sign and submit the <u>attached</u> nomination form (**Appendix III**), together with his/her brief curriculum vitae stating the relevant experience. The nomination should be made by two College Fellows.

The College Council will select the most suitable candidate, taking into consideration the following attributes:

1. Having experience in developing and supervising subspecialty training programmes.

- 2. Having served in the Council or Standing Committees of the College (be familiar with the operation of the College).
- 3. Having been involved in the development of subspecialty accreditation guidelines of the College.

#### **Abstract Submission Process**

#### **Electronic submission instruction**

- 1. Electronic submission is the preferred method.
- 2. Deadline for submission is 10<sup>th</sup> May 2010.

### Paper submission instruction

- 1. Abstracts may also be submitted on paper by mail to the congress secretariat.
- 2. Deadline for submission is 10<sup>th</sup> May 2010.
- 3. The entire abstract should be typed or laser-printed within the space provided in the abstract form.
- 4. A computer disk (either Macintosh or PC format) containing the text of the abstract must also be included. Label the disk with the name of contact author, the file name and the word processing program and version used.

#### **Submission Regulations**

- More than one abstract could be submitted but a separate submission form is required for each abstract.
- 2. Once submitted, abstracts will not be returned.
- 3. The Scientific Programme Committee reserves the right to edit the language content and publish the accepted abstracts in the official publications of the meeting.
- 4. There is no fee for abstract submission but presenting author selected for presentation must be registered for the meeting

### **Notification**

- 1. Authors who submitted abstract on paper will be acknowledged by mail. Authors who submitted via internet will be notified of receipt by email.
- 2. Notification of abstract acceptance will be sent to the presenter once accepted by the Scientific Committee via email followed by post **not later than 24<sup>th</sup> May 2010.**
- 3. Only the presenting author will be notified of abstract acceptance.

### **Preparation of Abstracts**

- 1. All abstracts must be submitted and presented in English.
- 2. Type the abstract using the form overleaf in single-line spacing in Microsoft Word format (6.0 is preferred) using 12-point font of Times New Roman. (maximum 300 words) Any abstract exceeds this limit will be automatically truncated.
- 3. Please type clearly within the frame, the title of the abstract in BOLD CAPITAL LETTERS, initial and last name of each author (do not include titles e.g. MD, PhD), name of the institution and country of origin on the top of the form, and underline the name of the presenting author. The author's name must be exactly the same in all abstracts when more than one abstract is submitted.
- 4. The abstract should contain summarized description of the following: a) Objective, b) Method, c) Results and d) Conclusion. Simple tables or graphs (in blank ink) may be included.
- 5. Standard abbreviations may be used. Special or unusual abbreviation must be placed in parentheses after the full word the first time it appears.

6. Non-proprietary (generic) drug names are preferred and should be written in small letters. Each time the proprietary name of a drug appears, the first letter should be capitalized.

#### **Publication of abstracts**

Abstracts will be published in the meeting abstract book.
