## **CME Committee**

### **Important revision on CME guidelines**

The council has endorsed on the following revision:

1. Instead of Fellows submitting their ARFs at the end of each year, College secretariat will retrieve the CME data of each Fellow from the Academy iCME/CPD website and notify each Fellow of their status by letter.
2. If iCME/CPD account shows that the minimum requirement for that year has not been met, the Fellow would be asked to verify his/her iCME/CPD account and to submit an ARF together with any amendments.
3. Once a Fellow has fulfilled the required minimum CME requirement for the 3-year cycle (i.e. 90 points, of which 15 points are active), he/she would be informed in writing, after which further individual CME applications would no longer be processed in order to relieve the workload of the College Secretariat.

4. There will NO more late administrative charges from the College. However, Fellows who do not submit their ARF and remain non-compliant at the end of year-3-cycle would be subjected to a late charge imposed by the Academy.

## **pGALS Screening Examination of the Musculoskeletal System**

*"....The first change is that the "Other" Station (Station 9) is to be renamed "Musculoskeletal (MSK)/Other". It is recognised that in many exams there are children with either gait or joint problems related to rheumatological causes. There is not to be any change in the way that candidates are assessed on their capability to examine such children. Designating this station as MSK will allow a clearer indication of the domain of clinical assessment required and will allow the host centre to provide good facilities to allow gait assessment for that station.*

*Please be reassured that this change will not require any additional exam preparation by yourself, nor any additional knowledge. It may be helpful for you in your normal preparation and training to have a look at the following website: [www.arc.org.uk](http://www.arc.org.uk) and look for pGALS. This is a teaching package for clinical assessment which candidates will find informative."*
