Message from the Editors

We were all extremely saddened by the news of the sudden passing of Dr. Brian Ho Hing-tung. For those of you who had the privilege to work with Brian would agree that he was a conscientious, approachable and capable paediatrician. Our College and the paediatric community have surely lost a great asset. On behalf of all members of the House Committee, we send our sincere condolences to his family.

Progress on Development of Subspecialty Accreditation

The Hong Kong College of Paediatricians has a statutory responsibility to ensure the standards and quality of paediatric practice through a reliable system of training, accreditation, and continuous professional development. The program in General Paediatrics has been running effectively for the past decade. With the advance in tertiary services and the planning of the future Centre of Excellence in Paediatrics, there is a need for a proper accreditation system of subspecialists. The College set up a Task Force for Accreditation of Higher Training of Paediatric Subspecialties in 2000, and through its hard work, has laid down the groundwork and guidelines for subspecialty accreditation.

In September 2008, The College Council has set up the Working Group on Accreditation of Paediatric Subspecialties to carry on the work of the Task Force. The terms of reference of the Working Group are:

- 1) To advise the College Council on accreditation of paediatric subspecialties in Hong Kong
- 2) To study the feasibility of implementation of paediatric subspecialties
- 3) To formulate an action plan
- 4) To assist in the implementation of paediatric subspecialties
- 5) To monitor outcome measures for success of implementation

With a broader representation by Fellows from all sectors and subspecialty interests, the Working Group will be able to provide impartial advice and facilitation of subspecialty accreditation. Furthermore, the Working Group will make announcements and seek wide consultation from all Fellows upon receipt of any application for subspecialty accreditation.

In the Council meeting on 12 May 2009, the College Council has also endorsed an amendment of the Byelaws by adding a section on Subspecialty affairs, as follows:

Section 10. Subspecialty affairs: The College shall supervise paediatric subspecialty development through the accreditation, training and examination of each paediatric subspecialty in accordance to the Guidelines for Recognition of Academy College of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine.

- (i) The Director of Subspecialty Boards shall be appointed by the Council to supervise all Subspecialty Boards and to carry out relevant duties as directed by the Council. He/she will be an ex-officio member of the Council and the interim Working Group on Accreditation of Paediatric Subspecialties.
- (ii) A Committee for Subspecialty Boards shall be formed to assist the Director of Subspecialty Boards in his/her duties. The membership of the Committee will comprise the chairpersons of Accreditation, Education, and Examination Committees, the chairperson of each established Subspecialty Board, one representative each from the Hospital Authority, Department of Health, the two Universities, Fellows in private practice, as well as one senior Fellow and one junior Fellow appointed by the Council.
- (iii) A Subspecialty Board shall be formed for each accredited subspecialty in accordance to the Guidelines on the Criteria for the Accreditation of a Paediatric Subspecialty Training Programme of the College.
- (iv) The term of office of the Director, Committee for Subspecialty Boards, and Subspecialty Board members shall normally be three years or as directed by the Council. Members of the Committee shall be eligible for re-appointment, but the Director of Subspecialty Boards shall hold office for no more than a cumulative total of two terms.

Obituary

In Memory of Dr Brian Ho Hing-tung (何慶形醫生)

The College records with great sadness the sudden passing of Dr Brian Ho Hing-tung on 24th May 2009, while engaged in a diving exercise off the coastal waters of Sai Kung, Hong Kong. Dr Ho was born in Hong Kong in 1963. He obtained his MB ChB from The Chinese University of Hong Kong in 1987, and an MSc in Epidemiology and Biostatistics from the same university in 2004. Upon graduation, he joined the Department of Anaesthesia of the Prince of Wales Hospital until he decided to pursue the career of a paediatrician. He joined the Department of Paediatrics of the same hospital in 1990 and later the Pamela Youde Nethersole Eastern Hospital in 1994. He developed an interest in neonatology and in 1996, received 6 months' training in renowned neonatal centres in the US, such as the Lucile Packard Children's Hospital of Stanford University, the Division of Neonatology of the University of California in Los Angeles and the Rainbow Babies & Children's Hospital in Cleveland. He became a Fellow of the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians and the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine in 1997.

Dr Ho was known among his colleagues and friends as a man who set high standards for himself on both the professional and personal fronts. No barrier was too high for him. On the professional front, he enjoyed coaching juniors. He was an instructor of the Paediatric Advanced Life Support Course organized by the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians since 2002. He was also instrumental in organizing the Medical Teleconference Programme on "Topics of Neonatology" jointly presented by the Department of Paediatrics, Pamela Youde Nethersole Eastern Hospital and Stanford University School of Medicine, which has now entered its eleventh year. His enthusiasm in helping underprivileged children in rural China could be witnessed by his active participation as a volunteer and instructor in the Neonatal Resuscitation Programme operated by the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians Foundation during visits to Kunming and Shangri-La in 2008. Work aside, Dr Ho was an accomplished sportsman, with diving, marathon running, skiing and mountain hiking as his major undertakings in the world of sports.

Dr Ho's tragic departure is a tremendous loss to many parties. The profession has lost an accomplished neonatologist who showed full dedication and commitment to the specialty. Our patients have lost a caring doctor who had devoted his lifetime in taking care of their health and welfare. His family has lost a filial son, a loving husband and a devoted father. Dr Ho will be fondly remembered as an excellent doctor and a good friend.

Dr Ho is survived by his parents, his wife, Dr Yonnie Lam, and their two children, Bernard and Bertha. We extend to them our most sincere condolences and sympathy at this time of great difficulty.
