## Eric Bouffet, MD, HDR

Professor of Paediatrics, University of Toronto, Canada Garron Family Chair in Childhood Cancer Research; Head of Neuro-oncology Section of Division of Haematology Oncology at The Hospital for Sick Children, Toronto, Canada

Professor Eric Bouffet graduated in 1980 from medical school at the University of Lyon, France. He trained and practiced in Lyon and became Head of the Department of Neuro-oncology, Centre Leon Berard, during the period 1992-1995. He was Consultant Paediatric Oncologist at the Hospital for Sick Children, Bristol (1996-1998) and the Royal Marsden Hospital, Sutton, UK (1998-2000). In 2000, he moved to The Hospital for Sick Children in Toronto to develop and head a multidisciplinary paediatric Neuro-oncology Program within the Division of Haematology/Oncology. In 2011, he became the inaugural recipient of the Garron Family Chair in Childhood Cancer Research. In 1998-2001, he was Co-Chairman of the Brain Tumour Committee of the International Society of Pediatric Oncology (SIOP). He was President of SIOP (2016-2019) and Chair of the Canadian Paediatric Brain Tumour Consortium. He is a member of the Steering Committee of the Brain Tumour Committee of the Children's Oncology Group. His research interests are in the area of novel treatments and clinical trials in children with brain tumours. He is author or co-author of over 450 peer-reviewed manuscripts and author/co-author on numerous book chapters in the field of neuro-oncology.
