In Remembrance of Dr CHIU Man Chun



Dear Colleagues,

With the deepest sorrow, the College Council shares with you the saddening news of our immense loss of a paediatrician giant and legend, our teacher and friend. Dr CHIU Man Chun peacefully passed away at Princess Margaret Hospital on 29 September 2021.

Dr Chiu was a pioneer in multiple fields of paediatrics. He was one of the Founders of our College and had contributed tremendously to the growth of the College, serving on the Council and in key roles of the College that have defined much of what we are today. His vision and leadership in our professional education and training, his exemplary role-modelling, compassion and care to nurturing generations of paediatricians and his devotion to be a witness of the love of God through his productive life will always be remembered in our hearts.

The College extends our sincerest condolences to Dr Chiu's family and in the space they will need at the moment, our thoughts are with them.

We pray together for Dr Chiu's eternal peace and are forever grateful for the legacy he has bestowed us with.

Tribute to Prof. Man-chun Chiu (1949-2021)

Prof. Man-chun Chiu has passed away peacefully on 29 September 2021 at Princess Margaret Hospital (PMH) in Hong Kong after fighting a courageous 10-year battle with cancer. He was 72.

For over past 40 years, Prof. Chiu has been one of our phenomenal leaders spearheading the development of Paediatric Nephrology in Hong Kong, China, and Asia. Having graduated from the University of Hong Kong (HKU) in 1974, Prof. Chiu was professionally trained in Paediatric Nephrology at the Great Ormond Street Hospital and Guy's Hospital in the United Kingdom. Upon his return to Hong Kong, Prof. Chiu was appointed the consultant paediatrician at PMH in 1988, and later on the Chief of Paediatrics for almost two decades. He was appointed Honorary Clinical Professor by the Department of Paediatrics and Adolescent Medicine, HKU since 2013.

Prof. Chiu dedicated his life to the care of children with kidney diseases. He always had the vision that Paediatric Nephrology could be much better developed in our part of the world. In his early days as a doctor, kidney failure was a deadly disease in young children. Prof. Chiu took on the challenge to set up the first Paediatric Nephrology Centre at the PMH and introduced the automated peritoneal dialysis, haemodialysis, and transplant services for children. He also co-founded the Children's Kidney Fund to solicit support from the local community on the recurrent expenses of dialysis and expensive medications. He was a caring and humble doctor, and that is why he is so loved and respected by his patients and fellow colleagues.

Following the successful establishment of the local service, Prof. Chiu decided to extend his mission to China. He travelled and taught extensively in the Mainland since 1997. With his advice and support, Paediatric Nephrology blossomed in China, and many new paediatric nephrology units were set up to save children's lives. To further strengthen the global networking in Paediatric Nephrology, Prof. Chiu helped found the Hong Kong Paediatric Nephrology Society in 1989 and the Asian Paediatric Nephrology Association (AsPNA) in 1996. He was appointed the Assistant Secretary General (Asia) for International Paediatric Nephrology Association (IPNA) in 2010. Prof. Chiu created a legacy and gained recognition internationally. He was awarded the AsPNA Achievement Award in 2013 and the honorary membership of IPNA in 2019. Additionally, Prof. Chiu produced over 80 peer-reviewed journal papers, book chapters, and paediatric textbooks which are still influential to the field up to this day.

Prof. Chiu contributed remarkably to the founding of the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians, leading to where we are today. He was particularly devoted to developing and nurturing young paediatricians and his vision on professional training had inspired countless practitioners both locally and overseas. Prof. Chiu was also the key convener of the Hong Kong Children's Hospital project team in 2007. It is obvious that his exceptional leadership and capabilities had laid a robust foundation for Hong Kong's first children's hospital.

Prof. Chiu is forever a fighter of truth, love, and excellence in all areas of his life. He is not only a legendary paediatrician, but also a musician, lyricist, and writer. Prof. Chiu will be fondly remembered by his loving family and life-long friends across the globe. His legacy will live on among those whom he knew, including those whom he had trained and worked with. He will be missed dearly forever.

30th Anniversary Scientific Meeting cum HM Lui Memorial Fund 20th Anniversary Symposium

Please be informed that our College will hold its 30th Anniversary Scientific Meeting on **4 and 5 December 2021 (Saturday and Sunday)**. The first day will be in a **hybrid** format with on-site presentations **at the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Jockey Club Building** and simultaneous online broadcasting. A number of sponsoring companies will set up exhibition booths on-site to disseminate health information to participants. The College Annual General Meeting, Fellowship Conferment Ceremony and 30th Anniversary Celebratory Dinner will follow right after this first-day programme. The second day of this Scientific Meeting will be held only **virtually**.

A number of overseas speakers as well as local experts will present on topics related to the following three themes: (1) Training and Preparing Future Paediatricians; (2) COVID-19 in Children: Vaccines and Beyond; and (3) What the Future Holds for our Children. Concurrently, HM Lui Memorial Fund will celebrate its 20th Anniversary by holding a symposium in this Scientific Meeting. Nine awardees will present their training experiences.

Besides these symposia, several companies will sponsor lunch lectures on both days to focus on important topics such as childhood vaccines and common skin and infectious diseases. A number of companies will also set up exhibition booths on-site on the first day to disseminate useful health and medical information to the participants.

CME points will be awarded to Fellows participating in the 2-day symposium. Our College is going to standardize the method of recording your online participation using the Google Form that is accessible via QR code (or URL link) displayed on screen at the beginning, break and end of the CME sessions. Colleagues attending the programme physically on the first day will continue to sign on the CME attendance sheet.
