## 2022 Best Young Investigator Prize

To encourage research by colleagues, the Best Young Investigator Prize was created in 2015 to be awarded annually to the best paper published between 1<sup>st</sup> July of previous year and 30<sup>th</sup> June of the awarding year.

## **Eligibility**

Entry into the Best Young Investigator Prize competition is voluntary.

Applicants must be members of the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians (including Associate Members, Members and Fellows) AND aged 46 years or under as at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

The papers should be published in peer-reviewed print or electronic journals, and written in English or translated into English if they are written in languages other than English.

Only the first author **or** corresponding author is eligible to apply. One paper is eligible for only one submission, and <u>each paper</u> will be allowed to compete for <u>only one prize</u>.

If the paper has previously been awarded the Best Dissertation Prize of the College prior to publication, it will not be eligible for the Best Young Investigator Prize and vice versa.

The decision of the assessment panel will be final.

## **Submission**

Submission deadline for the year 2022 Prize will be <u>15<sup>th</sup> September 2022</u>. Interested colleagues can email their papers (PDF or MS Word format) together with the Application Form (Appendix I) to the College Secretariat (<u>enquiry@paediatrician.org.hk</u>) <u>on or before 15<sup>th</sup> September 2022.</u>

The Best Young Investigator Prize will include a cash reward of HK\$5,000 and will be presented during the College 31<sup>st</sup> Annual Dinner in December 2022.
