The New Paediatric Training Curriculum – Part 1 of 3

The College will launch the new competency-based training curriculum on 1 July 2025. All trainees starting their basic or higher training on or after 1 July 2025 will have to observe the requirements of the new curriculum.

Where can I get information about the New Curriculum?

You can find information on the New Curriculum at www.hkpaedcr.paediatrician.org.hk or access through www.paediatrician.org.hk. You will find web-based information. You can also download the full version and a short summary on the website.

When will the College launch the New Curriculum?

The New Curriculum will apply to trainees who start their basic or higher training on or after 1 July 2025.

What is new about the New Curriculum?

The New curriculum is competency based, with expanded syllabuses on more subspecialties and has a detailed description of the new formative assessments.

What has the College done to publicize the New Curriculum to the fellows, members and associates?

The College has held engagement meetings with all the training institutions providing paediatric training. An engagement meeting will be organized for all fellows, members and associates after July 2024. The website www.hkpaedcr.paediatrician.org.hk is also available to provide information about it.

What is competency-based medical education (CBME)?

Competency-based education is not a new concept. Ensuring a doctor's possession of certain enduring competencies and skills has always been the prime objective of medical training. CBME focuses on developing the essential skills and capabilities that doctors should possess, including patient management skills, medical knowledge, communication, professionalism and the skills to pursue continuous learning and advancement. The curriculum makes use of assessments and feedbacks to develop these skills. CBME emphasizes the principles of adult learning, which is the learner learns according to need and take responsibility in ensuring one's own continuous development. It may have long-reaching effects on the career of doctors.

What does the new curriculum look like?

The new curriculum has three main elements:

- (a) A curriculum of 11 domains of competencies. This is closely modeled according to the Progress curriculum of the RCPCH and are mapped to the HK Doctors document published by the MCHK.
- (b) A list of syllabuses describing the scope of knowledge that specialists regard as attainable during a 6 year training.
- (c) Assessment methods – including the formative assessments (DOPS, MiniCEX, CbD and PaedMSF), the summative assessments (MRCPCCH exams and the exit assessment) and the trainer's reports

Announcement from Education Committee

Best Young Investigator Prize

To encourage research by colleagues, the College created the Best Young Investigator Prize in 2015 to be awarded annually to the best paper published between 1st July of previous year and 30th June of the awarding year.

Eligibility

Entry into the Best Young Investigator Prize competition is voluntary.

Applicants must be members of the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians (including Associate Members, Members and Fellows) AND aged 46 years or under as at 30 June 2024. The papers should be published in peer-reviewed print or electronic journals, and written in English or translated into English if they are written in languages other than English. Only the first author or corresponding author is eligible to apply. Each applicant should only submit one paper for consideration.

If the paper has previously been awarded the Best Dissertation Prize of the College prior to publication, it will not be eligible for the Best Young Investigator Prize

The decision of the assessment panel will be final.

Submission

Submission deadline for the year 2024 Prize will be **14 August 2024 (Wednesday)**. Interested colleagues can email their papers (PDF or MS Word format) together with the Application Form (Appendix I) to the College Secretariat (enquiry@paediatrician.org.hk) on or before 14 August 2024.

The Best Young Investigator Prize will include a cash reward of HK\$5,000 and will be presented during the College Annual Dinner on 30 November 2024. The winner will be invited to present the paper at the Annual Scientific Meeting on the same day.

	<p>產品特色</p> <p>「沙頭角禁區」</p> <p>沙頭角的名字來自一句優美的詩詞：「日出沙頭，月懸海角」。沙頭角位於香港新界北區，與內地深圳市鹽田區接壤，於 1951 年被列為邊境禁區。隨着該區逐步開放，沙頭角現今搖身一變，成為本地一日遊的好去處</p> <p>沙頭角之角</p> <p>沙頭角最東之角豎立着一塊標示經緯度的舊式路牌，前方還有刻上「日出沙頭，月懸海角」的石碑。相傳這是源自一位清朝大臣來到廣東沿岸視察，看見這裡風光如畫，便題下以上詩句，「沙頭角」因而得名。在這裡，你可盡覽沙頭角海灣的天然海岸線，靜下心神，你會發現耳邊傳來陣陣海浪聲，蓋過途人的喧鬧，時間彷彿停止流動，永遠凝在詩人被美景感動的一刻。</p> <p>日月亭</p> <p>「日出沙頭，月懸海角」，短短兩句描繪出沙頭角海的日月美景，而位於海灣一角的「日月亭」更是欣賞醉人景致的最佳位置。除了欣賞晨曦第一道陽光，到了黃昏時分，日月亭更是區內休憩熱點。你可靜靜地坐在亭中，將港灣的水光山色盡收眼底，細看被夕陽餘暉加冕的點點生輝。夜晚，你同樣可以在這裡細賞空中明月與琉璃般晶瑩的水面互相輝映的靜謐一刻。</p> <p>沙頭角海味街</p> <p>沙頭角街市及熟食市場主要服務區內居民，店主與顧客都是街坊街里，人情味濃厚，熟食市場內提供正宗的客家菜。這裡有一條主打售賣海味乾貨的「海味街」，當中不少花膠、魚鰾和鹹魚等均是自家製作，有些店舖更提供不同魚類乾貨預訂，甚具漁村風味！來到沙頭角想買海味作手信的話，就不要錯過海味街了！</p> <p>順平壁畫街</p> <p>位於舊消防局附近，除了街道名稱寓意順利平安，還有兩幅繪有精緻壁畫的牆身，牆上描繪的正是沙頭角標誌性的傳統文化活動——天后醮典！沙頭角居民至今仍會按傳統每年舉行天后誕，而每十年更舉辦一次大型酬神醮典，居民會熱烈慶祝，其中最具特色的可說是鶴佬婦女的「陸上龍舟」舞。慶典的畫面活靈活現地呈現在牆上，遊人可以透過壁畫感受到熱鬧氣氛。</p>

三文魚屋

最早期的沙頭角邨於1988年落成，目的是為了安置受鹽寮下村及菜園角村寮屋清拆影響的原居民。屋邨外牆本來只以素色修飾，但後期的迎海樓採用了有別以往的設計，七彩外型為沙頭角添上休閒風及活力。2020年起，沙頭角邨較舊期的公屋開始進行翻新工程，外牆也陸續被重新粉飾，部分樓宇被粉嫩的橙色包裹，配上白色橫紋點綴，乍看有點像三文魚，既特別又可愛。

中英街花園

中英街位處邊境交界，地理位置別具意義。基於保安理由，多年來只有持特定禁區許可證，並在中英街有實際居住、生活和工作需要的人士才可以進出中英街，對於其他香港市民來說，中英街是一個歷史見證地，亦富有神秘感。座落在中英街檢查站前的中英街花園設有一個許願瞭望台讓遊人可眺望中英街，一睹中英街的風采。大家還可在欄杆掛上許願牌，祈求願望成真。此外，中英街花園模仿香港舊式火車站進行設計，除了1:1的火車頭模型及復古車站牆身，園內更種上櫻花樹等不同植物，放眼滿是打卡熱點。

舊沙頭角消防局

位於沙頭角順隆街與順平街交界，於1962年投入服務，直到2004年2月18日正式退役，同日位於順興街的新消防局投入服務。舊消防局是沙頭角的特色地標之一，仍保留着昔日外觀，標誌性的紅閘比一般消防局的要矮上一截，顯示出當年在此服務的消防車屬於輕型類。門前還會不定期展示一部1:1復刻的百年前手推消防車，是全港唯一一輛存放在露天的舊式消防車展品，讓遊人得以近距離接觸細看！

尖鼻咀

本名龜山，比鄰后海灣及米埔，向東可遠眺米埔醉人風景，更有機會看到雀鳥群飛的壯觀景致，向西可眺望后海灣及深圳的景色，令人嚮往。岸邊更布滿一大片紅樹林，因深圳河大量泥沙沖刷，而形成一個遼闊的海灣。山上更設有唐夏寮觀光台，可遠眺整個米埔及天水圍景色，望遠鏡可讓遊客觀賞米埔及尖鼻咀一帶的鳥類的 Close up，並有濕地生態資料板，讓遊客更直接認識濕地雀鳥。

Guests are required to provide a copy of a valid Hong Kong Identity Document (Adult: Identity Card; Children aged 11 or below: Identity Card / Re-entry Permit / Certificate of Birth) in order to apply for entry to Sha Tau Kok under the "Visit & Sightseeing" category of Restricted Area Certificate.
