# The New Paediatric Training Curriculum – Part 2 of 3

## What are the competencies encompassed by the eleven domains?

The domains are

- (1) Professional values and behavior
- (2) Communication
- (3) Procedures
- (4) Patient management
- (5) Health promotion and Illness prevention
- (6) Leadership and teamworking
- (7) Patient safety and safe prescribing
- (8) Quality improvement
- (9) Safeguarding
- (10) Education and training
- (11) Research

## What are “Learning outcomes”, “Key capabilities” and “illustrations” listed under the domains?

*Learning Outcomes* are broad statements of mandatory training results

*Key Capabilities* are the essential skill a trainee must acquire

*Illustrations* are examples that can demonstrate the achievement of Learning Outcomes and Key Capabilities.

Learning outcomes and key capabilities are the yardsticks that assess a trainee’s progress.

## What are formative assessments?

Formative assessments are tools designed to facilitate feedback, encourage reflection and monitor progress in competency development. These assessments aim at supporting a trainee’s advancement. They will be used to replace case-logging.

## What are DOPS (Directly observed procedural skills)?

DOPS assesses the trainee’s capabilities of performing the essential procedures listed in Domain 3. A trainee should be able to perform these procedures independently . DOPS need not be repeated once a trainee is assessed to be an independent operator.

Simulation is acceptable in some procedures. Designated personnel at a training institution may be delegated to complete the DOPS assessment, but the record should be endorsed by a College trainer.

## **What is MiniCEX (Mini Clinical Evaluation Exercise)?**

This is a short exercise that a trainee performs a specific task during a patient encounter while directly observed by a trainer. The task can be history taking, physical examination, developmental assessment, management planning or patient communication, or any combination of the above. They are very similar to the stations in the MRCPCH Clinical Examination, although multiple tasks (e.g. history taking and physical examination or communication) can be combined into one exercise.

## **What is CbD (Case based discussion)?**

This is a short presentation and discussion by a trainee to a trainer about a patient after the trainee has studied the patient records. The trainee shall discuss the clinical presentation, diagnostic methods, investigations, management planning and patient progress, emphasizing on the learning points showcased by the case. It is likely a one-on-one personal “grand round”. There are two types of CbD, one covers all clinical areas in paediatrics, another focuses on safeguarding issues e.g. child abuse, welfare planning.

## **What is PaedMSF (Paediatric Multisource feedback)?**

This is modified from the Sheffield Peer Review Assessment Tool (SPRAT). Seven independent assessors of different levels of seniority are to give feedback over five different aspects:

- (1) Good clinical care
- (2) Maintaining good clinical practice
- (3) Teaching, training, appraising and assessing
- (4) Relationship with patients
- (5) Working with Colleagues

There will be an overall assessment at the end. Assessors may comment on the development of the trainee in the past 12 months and raise any specific concerns about the integrity or the uprightness of the trainee in this assessment.
