Workplace-Based Assessment (WBA) workshop 21 May 2025

On 21 May 2025, the College held a Workplace-Based Assessment (WBA) workshop to prepare paediatric trainers for the upcoming WBA launch in July 2025. The session aimed to boost trainers' understanding and readiness for the new assessment format.

The workshop was led by experienced instructors from Jockey Club Institute for Medical Education and Development (JCIMED) including Drs SO Hing Yu, Albert CHAN, CHAN Ping Tak, CHOI Yu Fai, Lawrence CHAN and seasoned instructors from our College, namely Prof Simon LAM, Drs Wilson CHAN, Janice CHOW and YEUNG Kin Yip, who shared practical insights. Their expertise provided a well-rounded learning experience.

Twenty-two trainers from all paediatric training units from the Hospital Authority and Department of Health attended, demonstrating strong commitment to paediatric education. Feedback was very positive, with many participants reporting increased confidence and familiarity with the WBA process.

The College is delighted with the workshop's success and recognises the need for ongoing support. Given the positive response, similar workshops will be organised soon to further enhance paediatric training and assessment quality.

We look forward to the benefits this preparation will bring to the July WBA launch and encourage all trainers and trainees to stay involved in future College initiatives.

Our College has approved the establishment of new subspecialty of Paediatric Cardiology which was also supported by the Academy of Medicine. Medical Council of Hong Kong has just approved the accreditation of the Subspecialty of Paediatric Cardiology (S68). The subspecialty board of Paediatric Cardiology will be formed after election later this month. First Fellows of PC have been acknowledged to come up the stage during Conferment on 6 December 2025 to receive the Subspecialty Certificate.

Our College is responsible for ensuring the standards and progress of paediatric subspecialty development in Hong Kong. In order to ensure that we maintain the highest standards possible for any subspecialty accredited by our College, we strictly follow all pre-requisite criteria set by the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine and our College. The relevant application procedures are available on our College's website (<http://www.paediatrician.org.hk>) under the section on "Subspecialties". So far, eight paediatric subspecialty groups have applied for accreditation and have become accredited subspecialties under our College, i.e., Paediatric Immunology and Infectious Diseases (PIAID), Developmental-Behavioural Paediatrics (DBP), Paediatric Neurology (PN), Paediatric Respiratory Medicine (PRM), Paediatric Endocrinology (PE), Genetic & Genomics (Paediatrics), Paediatric Haematology and Oncology (PHO) and Paediatric Cardiology (PC).

Categories of Sponsorship

I. Sponsorship offered by the Travelling Fund

1. The Hong Kong College of Paediatricians (HKCPaed) will offer sponsorships for eligible fellows attending overseas conferences, with particular focus on young fellows (defined as fellows less than 10 years after becoming a fellow of HKCPaed) thanks to the generous contribution from the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians Foundation (HKCPaedF). A sum of HK\$50,000 will be allocated per year for such purpose and any unspent sum will be carried forward to the next year up to a maximum of two years.
2. The amount of individual sponsorship will be decided by HKCPaedF. The maximum will be limited to registration fee, airfare and accommodation. The usual amount of sponsorship covers the registration fee and full economy airfare.
3. The offer will be open to all paid-up college fellows.
4. An announcement will be made in the College Newsletter or through the HKCPaed College website. Unless otherwise specified, the deadline for application is six weeks before the commencement of the conference.
5. The most suitable applicant will be selected by the members of the HKCPaedF based on a set of guidelines.
6. The sponsored sum will be reimbursed to the successful applicant upon receipt of conference report and a statement of major expenses.
7. HKCPaed may solicit assistance from fellows receiving the sponsorship to deliver presentations or create materials related to the conference in HKCPaed events.
8. The selection and decision made by the HKCPaedF will be final.

5. Other Sponsorship Availability

It is not preferable to have other sponsorship except under special circumstances, e.g. when the sum from the other sponsor is insufficient, or there being no other applicant or the other applicant's participation in the conference is important to HKCPaed etc. Such decision is to be made by the PGAC on an individual basis.

(Add score by 0-10 points (rounded off to the nearest whole number) depending on percentage of total amount that is not covered by sponsorship; e.g. if alternative sources provide \$1000 for a conference with air fare and accommodation totaling \$5000, then candidate A will receive 8 marks, if alternative sources provide \$4000 for the same \$5000 conference for candidate B, then candidate B will receive 2 marks)

6. Guidelines for discretion by HKCPaedF members (0-7)

- General paediatric meetings will be given more consideration than subspecialty meeting.
- Small subspecialties with limited resources will be given additional consideration for major subspecialties usually have more alternative sources for sponsorship.
- The content quality of the proposed meeting will be assessed. Usually, international meetings or major meetings organized by prominent societies will be given more consideration.
- Meetings not previously sponsored will be given more consideration. Only in special circumstances will the committee sponsor the same meeting in 2 consecutive years. Consecutive sponsorships to meetings of the same subspecialties are not preferred.

MRCPCH Clinical Examination

The next MRCPCH Clinical Examination will be held on **14-15 October 2025 (Tuesday to Wednesday)**. The application period will start from 14 July 2025 (Monday) and the closing date for receipt of completed application and associated documents is **25 July 2025 (Friday)**. Details of application and forms can be downloaded from the College website later.

Please be kindly reminded the changing in eligibility criteria will start at 1 July 2024: Applicants for entry to the Clinical Examination must be holding posts and eligible to practice in Hong Kong and have completed a period of training at least two and a half years from the date of graduation given on their diploma of medical qualification. Within a five-year period before the date of the Clinical Examination, not less than 18 months of College accredited training and 12 months of unselected emergency paediatric patients.

Please note that candidates have a period of 7 years to complete the Clinical Examination from the date he/she passed all the theory examinations. There is no limit to the number of attempts. If candidates are not able to pass the Clinical Examination within the seven years, he/she must re-sit the Applied Knowledge in Practice Examination in order to take the Clinical Examination again.

Parallel Recognition of Overseas CME Program

Introduced by the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (HKAM) in 2007, provides an alternative pathway for Fellows practicing Paediatrics overseas to meet both the CME requirements of their country of practice and those of Hong Kong Medical Council simultaneously.

Eligibility criteria for the program are as follows:

1. The Fellow must reside and practice in an overseas country.
2. The Fellow must be registered and practicing as an accredited Paediatric Specialist in their country of residence.
3. The Fellow must participate in a CME/CPD program in Paediatrics, as required by the relevant Paediatric College, Board, or Medical Council, to maintain their Specialist Registration in the country of residence.
