# Faculty and Curriculum Development Committee Support for Workplace-Based Assessment (WBA) Implementation

## Launching Electronic WBA in e-portfolio system (EPS) on 2 Oct 2025

A trial run of the Electronic WBA in EPS for trainers and trainees to familiarise the entire workplace-based assessment process from deployment and completion to reporting in the EPS environment was provided in September 2025. Commencing on 2 October 2025, the Electronic WBA on College e-portfolio system (EPS) has been officially launched for adoption across all training units. This initiative is a key part of the ongoing implementation of the workplace-based assessment aligned with our College's new curriculum in focusing on competency-based training in Paediatric specialty across all training units.

## Best Dissertation Prize (BDP) 2025

Thirty-one papers submitted by candidates who passed the Exit Assessments on 19 December 2024 and 19 June 2025 were considered for the Best Dissertation Prize. The 2025 Prize was awarded to Dr YU Geoffrey Chek Fei for his dissertation entitled “The severity and correlates of depressive symptoms in adolescents with obesity compared to normal adolescents in Hong Kong using a validated Patient Health Questionnaire-9 screening tools”.

## Best Young Investigator Prize (BYIP) 2025

4 papers submitted by College Fellows competed for the BYIP Prize. The 2025 Prize was awarded to Dr LU Evelyn Ruoyun for her paper entitled “Randomized Controlled Trial Comparing the Efficacy of Mydrin-P Microdrops Over Standard Dose Mydrin P for Pupil Dilation in Retinopathy of Prematurity Examination”.

### 55<sup>th</sup> Exit Assessment

The 55<sup>th</sup> Exit Assessment will be held on **18 December 2025 (Thursday)**. The application period started from 22 September 2025 (Monday) and the closing date for receipt of completed application and associated documents is **10 October 2025 (Friday)**. Details of application and forms can be downloaded from the College website.

For all trainees who started their basic paediatric training on or after 1 July 2009, a proof of completion of a formal Child Protection Course within their 6-year Paediatric Training Programme should be submitted along with the application.

For all trainees who started their higher paediatric training on or after 1st July 2020, a proof of completion of a formal Paediatric Palliative Care Course within their 6-year Paediatric Training Programme should be submitted along with the application.

Dissertations submitted for this Exit Assessment will be considered for the 2026 Best Dissertation Prize awarded by the College. Case reports will not be considered for the Prize.

## Best Candidate Prize for Exit Assessment

We are pleased to announce that starting in 2026, the College will recognize outstanding achievement in our Exit Assessments with the Best Candidate prize. This award will encompass candidates from both the June and December exam diets (Dec diet last year together with June diet this year) and will be presented annually during our conferment ceremony.

Only candidates sitting for the Exit Assessments on their first attempt will be considered for the Best Candidate prize.

College will award multiple prizes for candidates who achieve the same highest marks.

# Arrangement for Uncollected Certificates

The arrangement for uncollected certificates applies to:

1. Fellowship
2. Subspecialty Fellowship
3. Membership
4. Intermediate Examination Certificate

Starting from 2025, the College Secretariat will arrange disposal of uncollected certificates after 2 years of Fellowship and Membership conferment. A **one-time exercise** is arranged for collection and disposal of **uncollected certificates from 7 April to 30 October 2025 for the Fellows and Members of training programmes of Year 2023 and before**. ### **Parallel Recognition of Overseas CME Program**

Introduced by the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (HKAM) in 2007, provides an alternative pathway for Fellows practicing Paediatrics overseas to meet both the CME requirements of their country of practice and those of Hong Kong Medical Council simultaneously.

#### **Eligibility criteria for the program are as follows:**

1. The Fellow must reside and practice in an overseas country.
2. The Fellow must be registered and practicing as an accredited Paediatric Specialist in their country of residence.
3. The Fellow must participate in a CME/CPD program in Paediatrics, as required by the relevant Paediatric College, Board, or Medical Council, to maintain their Specialist Registration in the country of residence.
