Exception to HK MRCPCH Clinical Examination Candidates

The Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health (RCPCH) has granted the following exception to Hong Kong MRCPCH Clinical Examination candidates starting August 2006.

is As an exception to Hong Kong condidates sitting exams in Hong Kong only, candidates' whose 2-year registration periods have not expired and have one attempt left can apply to sit the clinical and written Part 2 Exam in the same diet. These candidates will have a separate application registration applied to them, i.e. their 2 years would start from the results of the Part 2, rather than the end of their current unexpired 2 year registration period with the proviso that the first eligible sitting will be the next diet and they do not skip a diet, thus their registration expiry date will be one diet earlier than the norm. Furthermore candidates cannot "bank" existing attempts and start their new period on the expiry of the old. i.e. a candidate has one attempt left in 2006/3, should they enter and pass the 2006/2 written exam, their attempt in 2006/3 will come from the new registration period not the old. They cannot say that as they still have one attempt left that their period will start from 2007/1 or that they should be allowed 3 attempts after the expiry of the initial attempt.:"
