Obituary

We are shocked to hear that two senior fellows of our College passed away after some months of illness.

Dr Antia Chan Mui Kwan

I have known Anita since 1973 when she joined the Paediatric A Unit of Queen Elizabeth Hospital as a house-officer. Since then, we had worked closely till she passed away on 1 October 1999.

Whether as a Consultant Paediatrician in the Caritas Medical Centre or as a private practising Paediatrician, she was loved by all her patients, colleagues and staff of the paediatric units. Anita was sincere to her friends, always ready to listen and willing to help. Her advice was timely and appropriate. On hearing of her fatal illness, her patients wept and the staff of the Paediatric Unit of Baptist Hospital took turn to prepare nutritious soup for her every day. Her sick-bed was often surrounded by visitors. A smile hung on her face and in her, we witnessed dignity, peace and certainty of her future. She had dignity because she presented her best on seeing her friends. She had peace because she slept well even with pain. She had certainty because she knew where she was going --- to Heaven with Jesus Christ in His Glory.

She is survived by her husband, Frank Keung, her daughter, Chi-Lin and her son Chi-Wai. They will always remember her as a caring wife and a tender-loving mother. Video records of the many tours they went on together would be forever cherished. Frank told me that the lawn-bowling friends were missing Anita's participation at the week-ends. In return, I told Frank that we, doctors practising in Argyle Centre, deeply missed her company at our breakfast discussions in the basement of the building.

Someone has said, "When nature removes a great woman, people explore the horizon for a successor, but none comes and none will. Her class is extinguished with her". That is the case here. There is

no-one resembling her around today and we are poorer as a result.

Dr Anita Li Ming Cheng

Dr Antia Li Ming Cheng, a senior paediatric fellow of our College passed away on 8 December 1999 after some months' illness. It was undoubtedly a great loss not only to her husband Mr Chen Tu-Suen and her family, but also to the community especially to the paediatric community.

Dr Li's illustrious academic and professional career is well known. She was one of the earliest mature medical students who entered the medical school after completing a master degree in USA. She was one of the rare women-students who were not deterred by raising a family and was able to graduate the medical school with flying colours, gaining many distinctions including even in Surgery, in the days when the discipline was dominated by men. She was among the rare breeds of seniors who were able to earn a doctorate degree (Doctor of Medicine) from the University of Hong Kong through years of research work and distinguished achievements.

Dr Li's was one of the pioneers in paediatric haematology-oncology work in Hong Kong. She was a most caring and dedicated paediatrician. Of the many major contributions she had made, Dr Li should be most proud of the initiation of the "Hong Kong Cooley's Anaemia Association" in 1981. It was the first and the most effective patients' self-help group in Hong Kong, established long before those concepts as "self-help" and "patients' rights" had even crept into the Hong Kong culture. Dr Li had also helped to promote various aspects of child health work. Her educational commitments had extended way beyond her teaching role as a University Senior lecturer, she had contributed significantly to propagating child health education through her long and dedicated services with the Hong Kong Paediatric Society where she was president and also an Honorary Life Member.

Her self-less dedication to work for the welfare of her patients and their parents has left with us a best role-model to follow. Her perseverance and courage to face various challenges will be the virtues we all yearn to possess. Her outstanding contributions to the children and the paediatric community will be sadly missed but long remembered. To Dr Anita Li's husband and Family - our college would like to offer our deepest condolences.

Appendix 2

Non-Fulfillment of CME Requirements

1. *Retired from active practice*

The Academy will inform the Medical Council that these Fellows do not fulfil the CME requirements but will allow them to keep the Academy Fellowship.

A Fellow will be regarded as having retired from active practice only if he/she:

- (a) has formally submitted a written declaration to the College that he has retired from active clinical practice; AND
- (b) has ceased to obtain a practising certificate from the Medical Council of Hong Kong.

A Fellow who subsequently resumes active clinical practice (or obtains a practising certificate from the Medical Council) will be required to make up for CME points as if he/she has never retired.

2. *Remediable non-compliance*

(a) Fellows must:

- 1) have achieved not less than 60 points within the cycle, OR
- 2) be certified to have suffered from a medical condition which Council considers as a reasonable cause for the CME non-compliance.

The Academy may, at its discretion, accept other conditions if supported by Colleges on reasonable grounds.

- (b) These Fellows must engage in a remedial programme to make up for the deficiency.
- (c) The reasons for non-compliance and the remedial CME programme must be endorsed by the Education Committee.
- (d) The remedial programme must be finished within the time specified by the appropriate College. In any case, the remedial programme must be finished within 12 months from the time of decision.
- (e) The next CME cycle of these Fellows should follow immediately after the previous cycle without any break. In other words, these Fellows will have to undergo normal and remedial CME at the same time.

3. *Non-compliance that are not remediable*

The Academy will inform the Medical Council that these Fellows have not fulfilled the CME requirements. Upon reviewing each case, a recommendation for Fellowship termination will be made. Reinstatement of Academy Fellowship shall be (a) at the discretion of the Council, and (b) upon payment of fees as determined by the Academy from time to time, and (c) subjected to requirements including remedial CME and/or reassessment as determined by the Academy from time to time.
