The proposal of an obligatory training module in adult neurology during the specialty training of Paediatric Neurology has been discussed during our last Neurology Specialty Board Meeting on 23 Nov 2010. **Subject:** Paediatric Neurology training proposal

Dear Dr Chan

We have spoken about the proposal of a Paediatric Neurology Subspecialty training program from the Paediatric Neurology Association of Hong Kong. I have attached the proposal herewith.

It has been reviewed by three overseas referees, namely Professor Lieven Lagae from Belgium, President of the European Paediatric Neurology Society, Professor Harry Chugani of USA, President of the International Child Neurology Association and Professor Michael Shevell of Departments of Neurology/Neurosurgery & Pediatrics, McGill University Canada. They unanimously recommended we include an obligatory training module in adult neurology, which we would like to propose to be 3 months at this time. As you said last time, the trainee shall attach to adult neurology trainer to do ward rounds and clinics during the daytime, and return to paediatric unit to be on call at night. Regarding the assessment, log books and constant reviews by the adult neurology trainer will be the minimum. We are also considering the idea of asking adult neurology trainers to be our examiners at exit too.

Please feel free to comment and also we would very much appreciate if you can bring this up to discuss at your next Subspecialty Board Meeting in November 2010. If you need our presentation at the Board Meeting, we would be delighted to present our case.
