Re: Announcement from the Council regarding Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP)

Scenario-based simulation training in neonatal resuscitation has been regarded as a core and effective training for clinical professionals in providing up to standard neonatal care. At the 140th Council meeting on 18 Sep 2012, the College Council discussed and resolved that all paediatric trainees should undergo formal structured training in neonatal resuscitation organized by the College or its equivalent. This was formally endorsed by the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine on 4 Dec 2012. The Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) will be included as a mandatory requirement for the Membership of the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians in the College Accreditation Guidelines.

Therefore, for all new paediatric trainees who start their training on or after 1st July 2013, applications for the Membership of Hong Kong College of Paediatricians should be accompanied by evidence of satisfactory completion of the NRP within their paediatric training.
