The MRCPCH Foundation of Practice & Theory and Science (formerly known as Part I) Examination will be held in Hong Kong in October 2013. Application details for entry to the above examination are as follows:

3. Entry Requirements

Candidates who wish to enter the examination must hold a recognized medical qualification.

The Hong Kong College of Paediatricians reserves the right to admission for the examination and priority will be given to candidates taking both the Foundation of Practice and Theory & Science (Part IA and IB) examinations.

4. Application

a) HK Opening Date: 2 July 2013b) HK Closing Date: 26 July 2013

- c) Candidates who wish to sit the examination in Hong Kong MUST apply through the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians by completing Form B (Application for entry to the MRCPCH Foundation of Practice & Theory and Science Examinations - Overseas Centres) and indicating which paper(s) you intend to sit.

5. Completing and returning of application forms

- a) Both first time applicants and re-entrants are required to complete "Form B-Application for entry to the MRCPCH Foundation of Practice & Theory and Science Examinations Overseas Centres"
- b) It is required that candidates' name should appear on the application forms <u>exactly</u> as they are on their diplomas in order and spelling.
- c) Re-entering candidates should fill in the correct <u>Code Number</u> on the application forms.
- d) Supporting Documents

Candidates who are entering the examination for the first time must submit certified true copies of the current annual practicing certificates and the certificates / diplomas of their medical qualifications and / or official translations authenticated by one of the following:

- i. Chief of Service of your hospital with hospital chop and signature
- ii. The issuing University or Medical School
- iii. The District Office of Home Affairs Department
- iv. A practicing solicitor
- v. A British Consulate or British Consul
- vi. The candidate's own Embassy or High Commission in the United Kingdom
- e) Completed application forms together with certified true copies of the candidate's diploma of primary medical qualification and the current annual practicing certificate and the examination fee should reach the College Secretariat <u>not later than 26 July 2013.</u> Applications received after the local closing date will not be accepted.

6. Method of Payment

The following examination fees should be paid by cheques payable to "Hong Kong College of Paediatricians." The examination fees in <u>GB Pounds</u> listed in Form B are <u>not applicable in Hong Kong</u>.

7. Withdrawal / Refund

- a) Candidates who notify the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health of their intentions to withdraw from the examination before the UK closing date, which is **12 August 2013** will be eligible for a 90% refund of the examination fee.
- b) Please forward a copy of the withdrawal letter to Hong Kong College of Paediatricians for reference and refund. Those who withdraw after the UK closing date or who are absent from the examination will forfeit their fee.

- a) **Examination Time**: 3:00 pm to 5:30 pm (Foundation of Practice) 7:00 pm to 9:30 pm (Theory & Science)
- b) **Examination Venue**: Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Jockey Club Building (the exact location is to be announced)
- c) **Admission documents** detailing the examination time and venue will be sent to candidates via <u>email</u> directly from the RCPCH 3 4 weeks before the date of the examination. <u>Candidate should ensure that his/her email address as appeared on the Application Form is clear and correct.</u>

<u>Information for candidates intending to take the Diploma of Child Health (DCH)</u> Examination

The DCH Examination is divided into two parts, written and clinical. The DCH written examination is the same as the MRCPCH Foundation of Practice (formerly known as MRCPCH Part IA). It is expected that the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians and the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health will hold a Clinical Examination for the Joint Diploma in Child Health in Hong Kong in October **2013.** This Clinical Examination is open to registered medical practitioners in Hong Kong but there will be a limit to the number of entries. Candidates who have successfully passed the Written MRCPCH Part IA since January 2004 or the written MRCPCH Foundation of Practice examination since February 2013 and have at least 6 months of Paediatric practice (resident medical officer or intern) in a recognized institution with acute hospital admissions are eligible to apply. In addition, candidates who passed the Part IA examination in May 2005 or thereafter should have the 6 months of Paediatric practice as stated above completed within 5 years prior to the date of the DCH clinical examination. Further details on the clinical examination will be announced at a later date.

A new format of the DCH clinical examination has been adopted since April 2011.
