CME Annual Return Form - Have you forgotten to send in?

All Fellows are reminded to send in their CME Annual Return Form for the year 1998 as soon as possible to the Secretary by post or fax (correspondence on page 1). The College needs to submit the reports to the Academy of Medicine for endorsement. Fellows who do not hand in their forms might not have their CME activities recognized by the Academy.

The 1999 Postgraduate Paediatric Course

The College has been organizing postgraduate courses for candidates preparing for the MRCP Part II/Hong Kong College of Paediatricians intermediate examination. The program this year has been revised. The course is now shorter, spanning 26 weeks, but with slightly increased number of teaching sessions. There will be 3 interactive workshops on clinical data using case studies, and more slide demonstrations and quizzes. Bedside teaching sessions remain unchanged.

A course fee will be charged: \$1,500 for College Associates, \$3000 for non-members of the College. Only bonafide registered course members would be admitted to the teaching sessions. Certificates of attendance will be awarded to those who attend no fewer than 70% of the sessions.

Enrolment for the course may be made upon nomination by Unit Head. Subject to the number of applicants, priority would be given to (1) duration of recognized training, (2) Part I holders and (3) paid-up Associates of the College.

Notes

- 1. Those who have been approved for Overseas Fellowship can enjoy 50% reduction of subscription.
- 2. Fellows over 65 are exempted from annual subscription fee upon submission of proof.
- 3. Fellows admitted on or after 1st July of each year need to pay 50% of subscription that year. No such provisions are made for Members or Associates.

The current annual subscription to the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine is \$2,500 and overseas fellows can enjoy a 50% reduction. A surcharge of 5% will be imposed if payment is not received on or before June 30, 1999. Please direct your payment through the College.

Fellows who have arranged payment by direct authorization should check if their upper limit of transaction has been reset at \$5000.

Applying Accreditation for Overseas Higher Training

The Accreditation Committee has simplified the procedure on applying accreditation for overseas higher training. Fellows are requested to submit their PROSPECTIVE application in the form of letter with a detailed programme of their attachment. The Committee will then furnish the applicant with a confirmation letter together with a log data sheet. Applicants have to submit a report within one month after the training with the log data sheet duly signed by the overseas supervisor for further processing.

Training in North District Hospital

The Council has approved the Paediatric nit of the North District Hospital as an accredited centre for basic and higher training in paediatrics.

Organizing Meetings with CME Accreditation? Contact the CME Subcommittee at Your Earliest Convenience

The CME subcommittee helps to accredit CME meetings and assign Category A or B points to them. A recurring problem is the late submission of application from the organisers of such meetings. While the subcommittee has tried its best to approve such applications as fast as possible, the approved CME points are frequently not shown on the announcement/poster. We would like to urge the organisers to remember to apply for CME points as early as possible, and to remind our Fellows to ask the organiser about CME points approved, or to look at the College Homepage for the updated information.

There is an updated table to institution-based CME Cat (B) meetings attached at the end of the Newsletter.

Overseas Meetings: Can CME Points be Applied in Retrospect?

The College has decided to accept retrospective applications of overseas meetings for CME points provided that applications are made within *one month* of the meeting and that Fellows can provide proof of registration or attendance.

Paediatric Advance Life Support (PALS) Course

June 2-6, 1999 organised by

Hong Kong College of Paediatricians The Heart Institute for Children, Hope's Children Hospital, USA

Introduction

The PALS Course is specially structured for doctors, nurses and other health care professionals whose daily activities require proficiency in the knowledge and skills of PALS.

The goals of the Course are to provide the participant with the information needed to recognize infants and children at risk for cardiopulmonary arrest; the information needed to prevent cardiopulmonary arrest; and the skills needed to resuscitate and stabilize infants and children in respiratory failure, shock, or cardiopulmonary arrest.

The course was jointly developed by the American Heart Association and American Academy of Pediatrics. The Course Director and Faculties are from major American centers and local experts who are certified PALS instructors from the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians. The PALS Provider Course is conducted over two days. The PALS Instructor course is conducted in one morning session for candidates who have successfully completed the PALS Provider Course.

Certification

Upon completion of the Course Lectures, Skill Station and Written Examination, the participant will be issued a Certificate of Attendance by The Heart Institute for Children, Hope Children's Hospital, USA and the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians.
