Support for the Seasonal Influenza Vaccination Program

A joint press conference on promulgation of seasonal influenza (SI) vaccination was convened by the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) on 30 September 2014. Representatives of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine and the Colleges listed below were invited to speak at the press conference. Our College was represented by Prof YL Lau to stress the benefit of vaccine for children aged 6 months to 6 years. The Consensus Statement (**Appendix III**), which is jointly issued by the following organizations, is enclosed for your information. As influenza vaccines are safe and effective, paediatricians are urged to encourage parents to bring forward their children for seasonal influenza vaccination for better protection of their health.

Consensus Statement on Seasonal Influenza Vaccination

季節性流感疫苗安全有效。

Seasonal influenza vaccine is safe and effective.

除個別有已知禁忌症的人士外,所有年齡六個月或以上的人士應每年接種季節性流感疫苗。 All persons aged 6 months or above should receive seasonal influenza vaccination every year except those with known contraindications.

專業醫護人員應推廣季節性流感疫苗接種,尤其是針對下列的高危群組,以減低他們因流感而 引致併發症、住院或死亡的風險:

Healthcare professionals should promote seasonal influenza vaccination, in particular to the following high risks groups to reduce influenza complications, hospitalizations and deaths:

- ◎ 孕婦
 - Pregnant women
- 居於安老院舍的長者 Elderly persons living in residential care homes
- 居於殘疾人士院舍的長期宿友 Long-stay residents of institutions for the persons with disability
- ∅ 50歲或以上的人士
 - Persons aged 50 years or above
- ∅ 有長期健康問題*的人士
 - Persons with chronic medical problems*
- ❷ 醫護人員
 - Health care workers
- 年齡介乎六個月至未滿六歲的兒童 Children aged between 6 months and less than 6 years
- 家禽業從業員
 - Poultry workers
- Ø 從事養豬或屠宰豬隻行業的人士
 - Pig farmers and pig-slaughtering industry personnel
