MRCPCH Foundation of Practice & Theory and Science Examination, 10 February 2015

The MRCPCH Foundation of Practice & Theory and Science (formerly known as Part I) Examination will be held in Hong Kong in February 2015. Application details for entry to the above examination are as follows:

1. Examination Date: 10 February 2015 (Tuesday)

#### 2. Examination Fee:

HK\$7,250 (both papers)	Foundation of Practice AND Theory & Science	(Part IA & IB)
HK\$4,500 (single paper)	Foundation of Practice only	(Part IA) (DCH written)
HK\$4,500 (single paper)	Theory & Science only	(Part IB)

#### 3. Entry Requirements

Candidates who wish to enter the examination must hold a recognized medical qualification.

The Hong Kong College of Paediatricians reserves the right to admission for the examination and priority will be given to candidates taking both the Foundation of Practice and Theory & Science (Part IA and IB) examinations.

#### 4. Application

a) From November 2013 onwards, all candidates <u>must apply</u> for MRCPCH written examinations <u>online</u> using the RCPCH website via the <u>member sign in</u> area <u>https://www.rcpch.ac.uk/user</u>. In order to access the online application form, you need to be a registered user. If you do not have an RCPCH online account, you will be required to create one using the following link:

The application period in HK will be the same as that in the UK. All candidates must adhere to the set application dates and times. Applications for all exams will open at 9.00am UK local time on the first day of the advertised application period and close at 4.30pm UK local time on the last day.

Online applications cannot be submitted before or after the published deadlines. If you

miss the deadline for any examination online application period, you will need to wait for the next exam.

Please note that your application is <u>NOT confirmed</u> until payment of examination fees is received in Hong Kong.

- b) Opening Date: 17 November 2014 (Monday)
- c) Closing Date: 28 November 2014 (Friday)
- d) Candidates who wish to sit the examination in Hong Kong MUST ALSO apply through the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians by **completing Form B** (Application for entry to the MRCPCH Foundation of Practice & Theory and Science Examinations Overseas Centres) and indicating which paper(s) you intend to sit.

### 5. Completing and returning of application forms

- a) Both first time applicants and re-entrants are required to complete "Form B-Application for entry to the MRCPCH Foundation of Practice & Theory and Science Examinations Overseas Centres"
- b) It is required that candidates' name should appear on the application forms <u>exactly</u> as they are on their diplomas in order and spelling.
- c) Re-entering candidates should fill in the correct <u>Code Number</u> on the application forms.
- d) Supporting Documents

Candidates who are entering the examination for the first time must submit certified true copies of the current annual practicing certificates and the certificates / diplomas of their medical qualifications and / or official translations authenticated by one of the following:

- i. Chief of Service of your hospital with hospital chop and signature
- ii. The issuing University or Medical School
- iii. The District Office of Home Affairs Department
- iv. A practicing solicitor
- v. A British Consulate or British Consul
- vi. The candidate's own Embassy or High Commission in the United Kingdom
- e) Completed application forms together with certified true copies of the candidate's diploma of primary medical qualification and the current annual practicing certificate and the examination fee should reach the College Secretariat **not later than 28 November 2014.** Applications

received after the closing date will not be accepted.

#### 6. Method of Payment

The following examination fees should be paid by cheques payable to "**Hong Kong College of Paediatricians**." The examination fees in <u>GB Pounds</u> listed in Form B are <u>not applicable in Hong Kong</u>.

(in one cheque)	Foundation of Practice and Theory & Science	
HK\$4,500	Single paper Foundation of Practice only	(Part IA) (DCH written)
HK\$4,500	Single paper Theory & Science only	(Part IB)

#### 7. Withdrawal / Refund

- a) Candidates who notify the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health in writing of their intentions to withdraw from the examination on or before 12 December 2014 may be eligible for a 90% refund of the examination fee, depending upon the circumstances and at the discretion of the Examination Committee.
- b) Please forward a copy of the withdrawal letter to Hong Kong College of Paediatricians for reference and refund. Those who withdraw <u>after</u> 12 December 2014 or who are absent from the examination will not receive a refund except in exceptional circumstances subject to the discretion of the Examination Committee.

#### 8. Examination Details

a) **Examination Time**: 3:00 pm to 5:30 pm (Foundation of Practice) 7:00 pm to 9:30 pm (Theory & Science)

b) **Examination Venue**: The exact location is to be announced

## <u>Information for candidates intending to take the Diploma of Child Health (DCH)</u> <u>Examination</u>

The DCH Examination is divided into two parts, written and clinical. The DCH written examination is the same as the MRCPCH Foundation of Practice (formerly known as MRCPCH Part IA). It is expected that the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians and the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health will hold a Clinical Examination for the Joint Diploma in Child Health in Hong Kong in October **2015.** This Clinical Examination is open to registered medical practitioners in Hong Kong but there will be a limit to the number of entries. Candidates who have successfully passed the written component (MRCPCH Part IA before February 2013 or Foundation of Practice after February 2013), and have at least 6 months of Paediatric practice (resident medical officer or intern) in a recognized institution with acute hospital admissions are eligible to apply, provided that the 7 year period since passing the written component has not expired. In addition, candidates who passed the Part IA examination in May 2005 or thereafter should have the 6 months of Paediatric practice as stated above completed within 5 years prior to the date of the DCH clinical examination. Further details on the clinical examination will be announced at a later date.
