#### **New Paediatric Specialty Training Curriculum**

The College is pleased to announce that the new curriculum, proposed by the Working Group on Curriculum Review, has been endorsed by the Council and Academy Education Committee.

The new curriculum features competency-based training. It introduces four formative tools that will replace case logging in future.

## **Hong Kong College of Paediatricians Foundation**

After 3-year delay with the COVID, our college foundation has successfully organized the third NRP teaching from 9 - 10 October 2023 in Ningxia. 12 of us and a nursing colleague, namely Drs. Cheung Kam Lau, Vincent Leung, Genevieve Fung, Polly Ho, Ellis Hon, Karen Leung, Wilfred Leung, Terence Ma, Elim Man, Allen Tang, Joseph Ting (from Edmonton), Yam Man Ching and Miss Chan Yim Fan had joined the teaching.

The course took place at the Medical University of the Ningxia General Hospital and successfully coached 98 participants following the debriefing approach of the AAP NRP program. Local teachers paired up with a teacher from the Hong Kong team to aid in small group teaching. Successfully passed candidates were offered newborn resuscitation equipment to facilitate continuing teaching at their unit. They reported significant reduction in neonatal mortality with advance in technology and evidence-based approach in care of the newborn and resuscitation since our program.

This successful program is followed by a visit to Xinyang, Henan as a preparatory visit and trainthe-trainer program to prepare our coming 3-year project in Henan. Young and enthusiastic paediatricians as well as experienced teachers are welcome to join us to this meaningful program which in going to happen in May 2024.
