- Entry requirement and Duration
- Core and non-core training modules
- * clinical training, relevant subspecialties and disciplines
- Local and overseas exposure
- * Perinatal centers* and surgical centers#
- * Transport**
- * Research
- Content and format

Elaborations

- * Entry requirement:
 - * After fellow in paediatrics
- * Total duration of subspecialty training: 3 years
 - One year can be overlapping with high training if neonatology training requirement is satisfied
 - * Core training: 2 to 2.5 year (One year can be overlapping with high training if neonatology training requirement is satisfied)
 - * Non-core training: 0.5 to 1 year (research in neonatology/overseas/other subspecialty; max 6 months each activity)

Elaborations (2)

* Core training:

- * more than one center
- * >/= two years in accredited tertiary perinatal centers
- * >/= 3 months in any one perinatal center
- At least 3 months in neonatal surgical service (not restricted to HKCH)

Elaborations (3)

- Non-core training modules /choices: (refer excel)
- * Overseas attachment: can be up to one year with prior approval
- * Training projects: at least one during training
- Neonatal transport (inter-hospital)
- * Training sites: annual deliveries >/= 1800/year, level 3
