- (vii) Certificate of the Neonatal Resuscitation Programme (For trainees who start their Basic Training on or after 1st July 2013)
- (viii) Certificate of Attendance of paediatric sedation course "Enhancing Sedation Safety in Children having Diagnostic & Therapeutic Procedures" jointly organized by Hospital Authority and Hong Kong College of Anaesthesiologists, or its equivalent. (For trainees who start their Basic Training on or after 1st July 2015)
- (ix) Training Records from LOG BOOK that should include:
 - Personal Data and Appointments (p6-p7)
 - Training Summary (p8-9)
 - Detailed Training Record Sheets (p10-32)

Certified true copies of Training Records are recommended for vetting instead of original copies as all supporting documents would NOT be returned and they would all be shredded & destroyed after vetting.

(x) Documentary evidence of overseas training (if applicable) and accreditation document from Accreditation Committee (for retrospective accreditation)

All true copies of documents are to be certified by the proposer.

Note: Applicants are not required to submit items with * if they were previously submitted to the College.
