## 27<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting, Fellows Conferment Ceremony and Annual Dinner on 1 December, 2018

The 27<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting was held successfully on 1 December, 2018 at Pao Yue Kong Auditorium of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Jockey Club Building. The minutes of the 26<sup>th</sup> AGM held on 2 December 2017 and of the EGM held on 10 June 2018 were endorsed.

The term of office of the four Office Bearers is due to expire this year. Notice of invitation of nominations for Office Bearers were sent to all Fellows on 27 August 2018 and as at close of nomination period on 2 October 2018, the College had received two nominations for each of the vacant posts for President, Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer. An election was carried out through postal ballot, and Dr Tse Wing Yee Winnie was elected as President, Dr Fong Nai Chung was elected as Honorary Secretary and Dr Lam Hung San Simon was elected as Honorary Treasurer of the College respectively for the years 2018-2021. Prof Leung Ting Fan, being the only nominee for the vacant post of Vice-President, was elected *ipso facto* as the Vice-President for the term 2018-2021.

Mr Kenneth Sit and Walter Ma & Co. were re-appointed as the College's Honorary Legal Advisor and Auditor respectively for year 2019.

The 2019 subscription fees would remain as last year, i.e. HK\$2,100 for Fellows, HK1,050 for Overseas Fellows, HK\$1,400 for Members, HK\$700 for Overseas Members and HK\$700 for Associates. The subscription fee for paediatricians aged 65 or above before 1st January 2019 would continue to be waived.

The Annual General Meeting was followed by the Admission Ceremony of the New Members and conferment of New Fellows and Subspecialty New Fellows from 4 subspecialties, namely Paediatric Immunology & Infectious Diseases, Developmental-Behavioural Paediatrics, Paediatric Neurology & Paediatric Respiratory Medicine.

We are indebted to Dr Lau Chor Chiu, Vice-President (GA) of the HK Academy of Medicine, Prof Sophia Chan, JP, Secretary for Food & Health of the HKSAR Government, Dr SV Lo, Cluster Chief Executive, New Territories East Cluster, Hospital Authority, the Hon. Dr. Pierre Chan Pui Yin, LegCo Member, the Presidents and representatives of Sister Colleges who showered grace to our day's events with their presence and blessings. The Annual Dinner was attended by about 120 members of the College and guests. The singing performance by Dr Joshua Wong, a PIID Subspecialty New Fellow, during Dinner was definitely one of the highlights of the evening. Everyone enjoyed the singing performance and many were particularly moved by the lyrics.

With the New Year ahead, we look optimistically to the future of our College as we make bold strides on together. We would also take this opportunity to wish all College members and their families a Merry Christmas and a New Year full of joy and happiness.

## Provisional Accreditation of Hong Kong Children's Hospital as a Training Center

Hong Kong Children's Hospital will start in-patient service at the end of March 2019. HKCH has now obtained the provisional accreditation from the College on the 5 subspecialties, namely Haematology/Oncology, Nephrology, Cardiology, PICU and NICU.

Basic Trainees would be accredited for 3 months (but no more than 6 months) in each subspecialty. The NICU training will be recognized for 3 months Basic training but this will not be counted as part of the 6 months general neonatology training required, ie. as elective training.

Higher trainees would be accredited for training in each subspecialty and the maximal training is 12 months in all the subspecialties except NICU which is recognized for maximum of 6 months only.
