Hong Kong May 2021 1st Diet

- 31 May 2 June (Mon Wed)
- UK COVID-adapted format but face-to-face at HKAM
 - Case scenario with role players rather than genuine patients
 - Provision of dependent cues to candidates instead of physical signs
- Total 48 candidates (16 candidates per day)

Hong Kong circuit

- Long stations (23 m) in the morning (6 rooms + rest stations)
 - History, Development, Extended Clinical
 - 2 rounds with same scenario, role players & examiners

- Short stations (9m) in the afternoon (6 rooms + rest stations)
 - Clinical x 2, Communications x 2, Video x 2
 - 2 rounds with same scenario, role players & examiners





History & Management [23 min]

- 4 min: Reads Candidate Information Sheet
- 1 min: Enter station, Examiner provide introductory statement
- 14 min: Take a focused history from a role player [in English]
 - Alerts: "5 minutes left to gather your history" & "end of history taking"
- 9 min : Candidate discusses the patient's problems and management plan with the examiner
 - Invigilator announces 3 min left & end of examination

Extended Clinical [23 min]

- 4 min : reads Candidate Information Sheet, reviews any audio/video/photo universal cues,
- 1 min : Enter room & Examiner provides introductory statement
- 10 min : Take **focused history** from role player
 - Alerts: "4 minutes left to gather your history" & "end of history taking"
- 2 min: Briefly summarises key findings from the history

Extended Clinical

- 8 min:
 - Describes examination process verbally with dependent cues provided from examiner
 - Summarises clinical signs
 - Interpretation of signs and what they mean
 - Differential diagnosis & important diagnosis to be excluded
 - Alert: 3 minutes left of station

Extended Clinical

- 3 min:
 - Recommend tests or treatment and why
 - Arrangement of follow up they would arrange and when
 - Forward plan or advice they would give to the family

Development [23 min]

- 2 min : Summarise key findings from the history

Development

- 8 min:
 - Describes developmental assessment process with dependent cues from examiner
 - Briefly summarises developmental signs
 - Interpretation of signs and what they mean
 - Alert: 3 minutes left of Station

Development

• 3 min:

- Examiner asks candidate questions related to clinical reasoning, which will vary depending on the specific focus of the scenario
- Examiner asks candidate question(s) relating to the diagnosis/cause, which will vary depending on the scenario
- Examiner asks candidate what follow up they would arrange and when
- Examiner asks candidate what role another specialist plays in ongoing care



 - Alert: 3 min left of station
- 3 min: Examiner asks candidate
 - what is the most likely diagnosis/differential diagnosis
 - expected complications
 - how they would be investigated and managed

 - Candidate identifies clinical signs from the video
 - Candidate formulates likely diagnosis/differential diagnosis
 - Invigilator warns 3 minutes left
- 3 min : Candidate formulates management plan
