Since the Appeals Panel meetings are usually scheduled in mid-April, end of August and mid-late December, that is, two (2) months after the **UK** Clinical Examinations, Hong Kong candidates wishing to appeal against their results in the October Clinical exam may have to wait until April the next year for their appeal to be considered.

However, candidates are **not** able to sit a Clinical Examination **with an outstanding appeal**. Hence, candidates should take note of this when applying to resit the Clinical Exam in February.
