Appeal & Resit Clinical Examination

Candidates wishing to appeal against their results in the Clinical Examinations must do so within 5 weeks of the results letters being released. Appeals should be in writing and sent to the following address:

Since the Appeals Panel meetings are usually scheduled in mid-April, end of August and mid-late December, that is, two (2) months after the <u>UK</u> Clinical Examinations, Hong Kong candidates wishing to appeal against their results in the October Clinical exam may have to wait until April the next year for their appeal to be considered.

However, candidates are <u>not</u> able to sit a Clinical Examination <u>with an outstanding appeal</u>. Hence, candidates should take note of this when applying to resit the Clinical Exam in February.

Six case reports on complex clinical conditions managed by the candidate (around 1000 words for each), or an essay type of 5000-word dissertation on a pre-approved topic or case cohort, or a research project that is published as a full paper in a peer-reviewed scientific journal should be submitted to the Secretariat by 31st August 2017 (postmark).
