Paediatric Update Series

The Paediatric Update no. 3 Seminar on Clinical Audit is scheduled to be held on **Sunday 18th** September 2011 from 2 pm - 5 pm at Hospital Authority Head Office Lecture Theatre. Clinical

audit is regarded by the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine to be an essential part of a Specialist's practice. In the new CMECPD Guideline effective from 2011, it is strongly recommended that Fellows should maintain a balanced CMECPD profile with a mix of different activities, including 5 points in a cycle from activities involving "Quality Assurance, Audits and Activities for improvement of Patient/Medical Care". In this Seminar, we have invited expert colleagues to share their experience in doing clinical audit in paediatric departments, general outpatients and private clinics. It is a good opportunity for our Fellows to know more about this area of CMECPD. We look forward to your support and participation in this College CME activity. Notice to Department of COS, Training Supervisors, Members and Associates

A significant proportion of late applications submitted by Members and Associates, which results in a deferral of recognized training, was noted recently. Not more than 6 months' counting back from their submission date could be recognized retrospectively.

Please be reminded that the trainee should apply to join the College as an associate within 6 months of joining as a trainee in the Basic Training Programme. Associate should apply for Membership within 6 months following completion of the Basic Training Programme.

It is also advised that the consequence of late application would mean part of the training not being recognized, and hence potentially a deferral of subsequent examination. Retrospective accreditation can be applied with a cost but there is no guarantee of full recovery of recognized training.
