### **Plagiarism Detection - Exit Assessment**

Starting from the June 2011 Exit Assessment, College will be running a plagiarism software to check on dissertations submitted by Exit Assessment candidates in order to ensure the originality of the reports. Exit Assessment candidates will need to submit <u>both hard and soft</u> copies of their dissertations.

#### **New Format – DCH Clinical Examination**

The Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health (RCPCH) will be launching a new format of DCH Clinical Examination in April 2011. The major changes involve the introduction of two new Stations, namely Data Interpretation and Safe Prescribing. #### 2:15 - 3:45 Problems in infant and young child feeding: the role of parents

We shall present a number of scenarios of apparently normal children with feeding problems commonly encountered in the primary care setting, including poor appetite, picky eating, meal time behaviour problems, etc. The prevalence of these problems in the community as revealed by a survey of parents' knowledge, attitude and behaviours of feeding infants and young children conducted in 2010 will also be shown. We shall then discuss the management of these problems and possible anticipatory guidance to prevent them, emphasizing the importance of the division of responsibility between the parent and child in the process of eating, as well as parents' role in providing healthy food choices and facilitating appropriate meal time behaviours.
