The 44th Exit Assessment will be held on **18 June 2020**. The closing date for receipt of completed applications and associated documents is **1 April 2020**. Details of application and forms can be downloaded from the College website.

For all trainees who started their basic paediatric training on or after 1 July 2009, a proof of completion of a formal **Child Protection Course** within their 6-year Paediatric Training Programme should be submitted along with the application.

Dissertations submitted by candidates for this Assessment will be considered for the **2020 Best Dissertation prize** (**BDP**). The BDP was created in 2015 and awarded annually by the College to the best dissertation submitted for Exit Assessments. Case reports, however, will not be considered for the prize. The BDP includes a cash prize of HK\$3,000, and will be presented at the College Annual Dinner in December.

Cancellation of 2020 1st Quarter Examinations

In view of the Novel Coronavirus outbreak in Hong Kong, the **MRCPCH Clinical Exam** which was set to take place on 25-26 February 2020 has been cancelled. Information on subsequent arrangements will be provided in due course.

The MRCPCH theory exam, **Foundation of Practice Theory and Science**, which was scheduled to be held in Hong Kong on 12 February 2020 has also been cancelled amid growing concerns over the risk in question. Candidates will be informed for full refunds of examination fees.

Hong Kong College of Paediatricians HM Lui Memorial Fund

The Hong Kong College of Paediatricians established the HM Lui Memorial Fund in Year 2001 to promote postgraduate study and research in liver diseases and related disciplines in children.

Applications are invited for the HM Lui Fellowship, which will be awarded to residents of Hong Kong SAR who are able to meet the following minimum criteria:

The HM Lui Fellowship

The HM Lui Fellowship will be awarded to paediatricians for education, training and research in overseas countries **in any field of Paediatrics**, preferably liver diseases and gastroenterology in the year 2020. The applicant must be aged below 40 years; residents of Hong Kong SAR and are currently working in Hong Kong SAR.

The award of the Fellowship will consist of:

- 1. Round trip airfare (economy class) by the most economical route.
- 2. Monthly allowance of HK\$12,000-HK\$15,000.
- 3. Reimbursement of course fees and books up to HK\$6,000.

The award of the Fellowship shall range from three (3) to twelve (12) months. Application must be made by nomination by the Head of the Department of Paediatrics or Hospital Chief Executive. The deadline of application is 9 April 2020.
