# **Inclusion of Pneumococcal Vaccine into the Childhood Immunisation Programme**

According to recommendations from the Scientific Committee on Vaccine Preventable Diseases, it is advisable for children under 2 to be vaccinated against pneumococcal infection to prevent serious complications.

Starting 1 September 2009, this vaccine will be added to the Childhood Immunisation Programme and provided to all Hong Kong newborns. Paediatricians would definitely benefit from more information regarding this new programme especially when enquiries from parents raised with mass publicity activities in July/August. Moreover, publicity materials regarding this initiative have been produced (poster and pamphlets) and paediatricians practising in the private sector may find them useful for display/dissemination in their clinics.
