Cold and Cough Preparations

Our colleagues should be aware of the recommendations against the use of non-prescription cough and cold preparations in young children by the relevant authorities in USA and UK. The following links are attached for your information.

Donations raised for Sichuan Earthquake

HKCPF has decided to donate the fund raised, amounting to RMB 320,000.00, to sponsor the project of "School Social Work in Mianzhu" in collaboration with the Department of Applied Social Sciences of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University. The fund would be used for sponsoring one year expenses for Hangwang School in Hangwang Town of Mianzhu.

Hangwang School in MianZhu has a capacity for 1700 students. The project will run an activity centre within the school to provide professional social work services such as case work, group work community projects. The donation goes to employ full time social workers, allowances for volunteers, program expenses, equipments, toys, books, training materials, furnishing expenses for the activity centre and IT facilities etc. Clinical psychologists from the HK Polytechnic University will visit the Centre regularly to train and supervise the local workers.

Hopefully this will provide a prototype of school social work program that would appropriately meet the psycho-social developmental needs of primary and secondary students and their families in the context of post-earthquake Sichuan.

The project has already started in early February 2009. The Mayor of Mianzhu has visited the work station there on 23 February 2009 as an acknowledgement for the establishment.

Fellows of HKCPF are invited to visit the work station in due course to see the progress of the project. Meanwhile we thank you for your kind donations for this worthy cause.

Obituary

Our Fond Memory of the Late Dr. Robert H.P. Fung (馮慶彪醫生)

Dr. Robert Fung graduated from the Harvard College in 1956 and continued his medical education at the McGill University, where he was awarded MD in 1960. He then furthered his internship and residency training at the Royal Victoria Hospital, Montreal, the Montreal Children's Hospital, and the Children's Hospital Medical Centre in Boston, Massachusetts, USA. He was awarded the Fellowship of the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada and Diplomate of the American Board of Pediatrics before he returned to Hong Kong where he contributed as a member of the teaching faculty at the Department of Paediatrics, the University of Hong Kong until he commenced his private practice in paediatrics and child health in 1968. He continued his teaching at the University of Hong Kong as a Clinical Associate Professor of Paediatrics and was one of the most popular teachers.

As a senior paediatrician in Hong Kong, Dr. Fung had witnessed the development of paediatrics and child health locally and across Asia Pacific. He was instrumental in the formation of the College in 1991 and became a subscriber and Founding Fellow of the College. He made enormous contributions to the College by serving as a member of the Council from 1991 to 1995 and as the Chairman of the Professional and General Affairs Committee from 1991 to 1995. He was awarded the Fellowship of Hong Kong Academy of Medicine in Paediatrics in 1993.

Dr. Fung had contributed greatly to the growth and development of the Hong Kong Paediatric Society, serving as President during the period of 1971-72 and as Council Member for the following five years. He was the Advisor to the Fundraising Committee of the 9th Asian Congress of Paediatrics in 1997. Dr. Fung was awarded Honorary Life Membership of the Hong Kong Paediatric Society in 2001.

Dr. Fung had excelled as a prominent figure speaking for children in Hong Kong. He had been the Founding Chairman for the Hong Kong Committee for UNICEF since 1986, Founding President of the Baby Friendly Hospital Initiative Hong Kong Association, Past President of the Rotary Club of Hong Kong, Board Member of the Hong Kong Thalassaemia Foundation and of the Families of SMA Foundation. He had dedicated himself to the welfare and rights of children and the promotion of breast-feeding. Dr. Fung's talent was not restricted to the Art and Science of Medicine, he was known as one of the top golf players in Hong Kong and internationally.

As is clear to all, Dr. Robert Fung was a senior paediatrician of high standing, a gentleman of great integrity and a child health advocate of immense contribution. Throughout his professional career, he had rendered notable service to the Society and significant contribution towards the advancement of knowledge in paediatrics and the betterment of child health in Hong Kong.

We are all sad that Dr. Fung has left us. To the profession, we have lost a great leader, a respected senior, a close friend and a great multi-talented colleague. To our children, they will forever miss this great paediatrician who had devoted his lifetime to the promotion of their health and welfare. He will be eternally remembered by us all in the medical profession.

To his family we would like to convey our most sincere condolences.
