Message from the Editors



RCPCH Conference Singapore

Date: 6 March 2021 (Sat) - 7 March 2021 (Sun)

Time: 09:00 - 17:00 (Singapore Standard Time SGT which is same as HK and 8-hour ahead of UK Time)

The first Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health (RCPCH) International Conference to be held outside UK will be entirely virtual and take place in the first weekend of March 2021. Sponsorship to Hong Kong participants will be offered by the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians and the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians Foundation to cover up to 100% of the registration fee. For Fellows and Trainees who have accepted abstracts, the College will cover 100% of the registration fee, while passive participants will receive support for 2/3 of the registration fee. 


