Due to the sheer volume of the completed application forms for the MRCPCH Part I Examination received by the RCPCH from all overseas centres, the RCPCH has requested all overseas centres to send their candidate application forms at least one week before the UK opening dates to allow more time for them to process the applications. This means that College will call for applications for the MRCPCH Part I Examination earlier than it usually does starting with the 13th January 2009 Part I Examination.
