# The 5th Guangdong-Hong Kong Paediatric Exchange Meeting

The Meeting was a success with about 150 participants and over 70 of whom were from Guangdong. ## **CME Subcommittee**

As resolved by the Council of Hong Kong College of Paediatricians and as has already been announced to all Fellows in March 2004, this serves as a reminder that, in accordance with Hong Kong Academy of Medicine's announcement, all Fellows will commence their CME cycles afresh on 1st January 2005 so as to synchronize with the duration of Practising Certificate following the decision of the Medical Council of Hong Kong to make CME a requirement for practising doctors.

In order to achieve this, all Fellows will have their CME cycles ending on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004. For those Fellows whose CME cycles originally ended in June 2004, their cycles have been extended by 6 months to end in December 2004. For the CME points requirements, please refer to Appendix 2.

In addition, ALL Fellows are required to send in their Annual Return Forms at the end of December 2004. For those Fellows whose cycle year started in January, their Annual Return Forms should cover the period from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2004 to 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2004 (i.e. the past one year). For those Fellows whose cycle year started in July, their Annual Return Forms should cover the period from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2003 to 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2004 (i.e. the past 1 ½ years). All Fellows are reminded to plan their CME activities accordingly.

## H. M. LUI Memorial Fund

The Hong Kong College of Paediatricians established the H. M. LUI Memorial Fund in Year 2001 to promote postgraduate study and research in liver diseases and related disciplines in children.

Applications are invited for the H.M. LUI Fellowship, which will be awarded annually to

those who are able to meet the following minimum criteria:

## THE H. M. LUI FELLOWSHIP

The H. M. LUI Fellowship will be awarded to paediatricians (or medical graduates) of ethnic Chinese origin aged below 40 years, including but not exclusive of the residents of Hong Kong SAR and of the Mainland of China, for education, training and research in the United Kingdom in paediatric liver diseases or gastroenterology in Year 2004-2005.

The award of the Fellowship will consist of:

- 1. An air passage by the most economical route.
- 2. Monthly allowance of HK\$10,000.
- 3. Reimbursement of course fees and books up to HK\$6.000.

The award of the Fellowship shall be for a period of six months. Application must be made by nomination by the Head of the Department of Paediatrics or Hospital Chief Executive. The deadline of application is 31 October 2004.


