Examination Committee

Arrangements for MRCPCH Part I and Part II Written Examinations In Case of Bad Weather

The Council endorsed at its 107th meeting on 12 March 2007 and the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health has agreed to the Examination Committee's proposal of adopting the following arrangements set by the British Council (May 2004) for **the MRCPCH Part I and Part II Written Examination in case of bad weather**.

Typhoon or rainstorm warning issued <u>before</u> an examination

- Typhoon warning signal No. 3 or Amber / Red rainstorm warning all examinations will be held as scheduled.
- If a No. 8 signal or Black rainstorm warning is likely:

Candidates should listen to radio or watch television in case the weather deteriorates suddenly.

• When the Black rainstorm or Typhoon signal No. 8 is announced:

Examination will be cancelled if the signal is still in force 2 hours before the examination starts.

Typhoon or rainstorm warning issued during the examination

• Once an examination session has started, it will continue for the full time allotted unless physical conditions in the venue are considered dangerous.

Candidates should call the British Council Examination Services at **29135170** if in doubt before leaving for the examination centre. A taped message will give candidates an up-to-date report on the status of all examinations due to be held that day.

With regard to the MRCPCH Clinical Examination, the DCH Clinical Examination and the Exit Assessment, the Examination Committee will consider the overall situation and weather condition to decide whether the examination/assessment should be cancelled or postponed during bad weather.

HKCPaed Foundation Cambodia Medical Mission Trip

The trip is jointly organized by Hong Kong College of Paediatricians Foundation and The Chinese Rhenish Church Hong Kong Synod Mission

Date: 13 – 18 October, 2007 (Saturday- Thursday)

Place: Phnom Penh, nearby villages and poor relocation settlements

- **Objectives:** to set up a mobile clinic and at the same time, cooperate with the local professionals to provide free medical consultations to Cambodian citizens
 - to deliver talks and organize seminar on "Community Health"
 - to visit Children's Home for runaway street youngsters
 - to arrange field visits to hospitals

H. M. LUI Memorial Fund

The Hong Kong College of Paediatricians established the H. M. LUI Memorial Fund in Year 2001 to promote postgraduate study and research in liver diseases and related disciplines in children.

Applications are invited for the H.M. LUI Fellowship, which will be awarded to residents of Hong Kong SAR who are able to meet the following minimum criteria:

THE H. M. LUI FELLOWSHIP

The H. M. LUI Fellowship will be awarded to paediatricians for education, training and research in the United Kingdom **in any field of Paediatrics**, preferably liver diseases and gastroenterology in the year 2007-2008 The applicant must be of ethnic Chinese origin aged below 40 years; Residents of Hong Kong SAR and are currently working in Hong Kong SAR.

The award of the Fellowship will consist of:

- 1. Round trip airfare (economy class) by the most economical route.
- 2. Monthly allowance of HK\$10,000.
- 3. Reimbursement of course fees and books up to HK\$6,000.

The award of the Fellowship shall range from three (3) to twelve (12) months. <u>Application must be</u> made by nomination by the Head of the Department of Paediatrics or Hospital Chief Executive. **The** deadline of application is 30th June, 2007.
