Overseas Membership and Fellowship

Eligibility, Rights and Responsibilities

1. Fellows or Members who stay away from Hong Kong for at least 2 years may apply for Overseas Fellowship or Membership.
2. Overseas Fellows or Members may enjoy a 50% reduction in subscription fees. The reduced rate will apply from the next calendar year after the approval of the change of membership status by the Membership Committee and College Council.
3. Overseas Fellows or Members must change back to local Membership or Fellowship upon returning to Hong Kong for 3 months or more.
4. Overseas Fellows or Members will have the right to receive journals, newsletters and annual reports of the College; to use College facilities in HKAM and to attend College meetings during their visits to Hong Kong.
5. Overseas Fellows have the right to vote.
6. They will not receive local correspondences.
7. Overseas Fellows should fulfill CME requirements. CME requirements is required should they want their names to be included in the Specialist Register of the Hong Kong Medical Council. To register for the parallel recognition scheme, one needs prospective approval from the CME Subcommittee. For details, please refer to the College CME Guidelines (College website CME Overview of CME/CPD).

Procedure of Application

1. The applicant should fill in the application form and send it to the Hon. Secretary of the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians.
2. The application has to be approved by the Membership Committee and endorsed by the Council.
3. The applicant will be informed of the result of application. The reduced subscription rate will apply from the next calendar year.
4. Fellows or Members, upon returning to Hong Kong for 3 months or more, will have to be reverted back to local membership and pay a full rate in the year that follows.
