Free Trial of Part-task Trainers offered to College Fellows and Trainees (16 July-15 September 2014)

The Hong Kong Jockey Club Innovative Learning Centre for Medicine (HKJC ILCM) has been offering free trial of the Part-task Trainers to College Fellows and trainees. The simulators offered in the training included LAP Mentor, GI/BRONCH Mentor and HeartWorks Dual Transesophageal echocardiography (TEE)/ Transthoracic echocardiography (TTE). Please refer to Appendix 3 for details of the simulators.

Here is the arrangement for the free trial of Part-task Trainers:

- 1. The 2-month free trial period will be from 16 July 2014 to 15 September 2014;
- 2. Each trial session will last for 2 hours;
- 3. Each session can accommodate a maximum of 3 Fellows / trainees;
- 4. It is not necessary for the trainee to be accompanied by a Fellow;
- 5. Fellows / trainees who wish to book a trial session must complete a booking from and submit it through their College;
- 6. Booking for Saturday/Sunday/evening sessions must be made at least 7 days in advance; bookings for weekday sessions should be made as early as possible;
- 7. Bookings will be on first-come-first served basis;
- 8. Should a Fellow / trainee be unable to attend a booked trial session, he must inform HKJC ILCM as soon as possible;
- 9. HKJC ILCM has the right to cancel any booking when deemed necessary.

Hong Kong College of Paediatricians Developmental-Behavioural Paediatrics Subspecialty Training Programme Information for Application

Subspecialty Description

Developmental-Behavioural Paediatrics (DBP) is a discipline of Paediatrics that deals with the evaluation, treatment and management of children with or at risk for developmental, learning, emotional and behavioural problems, through an understanding of the underlying biological and social factors, and delivered in context of the children's lives and families. It emphasizes evidence based practice, multidisciplinary and cross sector collaboration, and aims to promote the optimal development and behavioural health of all children.

Intake for Training Programme

This invitation is for the DBP training programme that has commenced on 1st December, 2013. The training programme cycle normally begins in January and July. Invitations for the training programme may be issued around January and July for subsequent cycles. Training Programmes for accepted candidates will commence when training resources can be confirmed.

Eligibility

- Specialists holding the qualification of FHKAM (Paediatrics) or its equivalent, or
- Candidates who have completed 3 years basic training in general paediatrics and have passed the Joint MRCPCH(HK)/Hong Kong College of Paediatricians Intermediate Examination are eligible to receive up to a maximum of one cumulated year of DBP subspecialty training experience during their higher training in general paediatrics, subject to prior approval of the proposed training by the DBP Subspecialty Board;
- Fluency in spoken Cantonese and basic level of written Chinese.

This is a 3 years training programme, with a maximum of one cumulated year or training received during Higher Training in general paediatrics, subject to approval of the DBP Subspecialty Board.
